

APPENDIX E-353 P

REJECTED FORCE FREEZE RELEASE NOTIFICATION

1. PURPOSE

This procedure is applicable to chapter 42 and prescribes the method to be used to process a Rejected Force Freeze Release Notification, appendix F-18. The notice provides a record of the manager directed release action and the quantity which failed to process because of insufficient assets at the storage location indicated.

2. APPENDICES USED

- a. Appendix B-243.
- b. Appendix E-179 P.
- c. Appendix F-18.
- d. Appendix F-167.

3. RESPONSIBLE ORGANIZATIONAL ELEMENT

The responsible organizational element for processing the notification will be the IM within the appropriate Commodity Branch, DSO. A complete F-18 will be furnished each Inventory Management Division (IMD) and the portion containing NSNs not applicable to the IMD may be discarded. Since the F-18 notification does not printout by specific ORC of NSN, the Commodity Section Control Clerk will make distribution to the applicable IM by NSN.

4. INSTRUCTIONS

- a. Data elements contained in the notification are explained in appendix F-18.
- b. Initial action to be taken will be to request a Standard Supply Control Study, appendix F-167, for review of the current status of the NSN by preparing an SSCS Request Transaction in accordance with appendix E-179 P.
- c. Subsequent actions will depend on the elements of data on the notification and the SSCS.
- d. Possible actions include:
  - (1) Force release of frozen assets at another storage site by preparation of a Manager Directed Backorder Release as prescribed by appendix B-243.

(2) Convert to a direct delivery.

(3) Make manual substitution.

(4) Initiate manual PR to replenish assets.

(5) Take no action (dues-in sufficient to cover backordered quantity).

e. The notice may be destroyed after it has served its purpose.
