

APPENDIX E-381 P

REVIEW OF STATUS OF SELECTED WEAPON SYSTEMS REPORTS

1. PURPOSE

This procedure is applicable to chapter 51 and provides instructions involved in the review and analysis of selected Weapon Systems reports resulting from the monthly/weekly process.

2. APPENDICES USED IN THIS PROCESS

- a. Appendix A-38, Weapon System Essentiality Codes (WSECs)/Weapon System Maintenance Codes (WSMCs).
- b. Appendix A-44, Weapon System Designator Codes (WSDCs)/Weapon System Indicator Codes (WSICs).
- c. Appendix B-272, Weapon System Summary Status Report Transaction, DIC CWS.
- d. Appendix E-305 P, Weapon System Nonstock Items.
- e. Appendix E-388 P, Weapon System Out of Stock Items.
- f. Appendix F-112, Weapon System Summary Status Report.
- g. Appendix F-112A, Weapon System Summary Status Report (Special Project Report Monthly).
- h. Appendix F-112B, Weapon System Summary Status Report (Special Project Report Weekly).
- i. Appendix F-137, Weapon System Item File (WSIF) Writeout Report.
- j. Appendix F-138, Weapon System Items Out of Stock Report.
- k. Appendix F-139, Weapon System Nonstock Items Report.

3. RESPONSIBLE ORGANIZATIONAL ELEMENT

The Weapon System Monitor at each Defense Supply Center (DSC) is responsible for receipt, review, analysis, compiling appendices F-112, F-112A, F-112B, F-137, F-138, and F-139 as applicable for development of statistics and reports on a monthly/weekly (F-112B only) review basis. These analyses are furnished as needed internally and/or upon request to DLSC-CSS.

4. PROCEDURES/INSTRUCTIONS

- a. At the end of each month (week for the F-112B), the monitors will request appendices F-138 and F-139 and appendices F-112, F-112A, F-112B (F-112A and F-112B only available on the WSDB), and F-137.

b. Monthly, the updated source documents (specifically the F-112 Report) will then be analyzed and developed into statistical analysis data for the Status of Selected Weapon Systems Report, DLA Form 444.

c. Review, analysis and comparison of the data elements of the appendices F-137, F-138, F-139, and other elements of the Weapon System Master File and other basic files should be compared for accuracy and reflected on the monthly DLA Form 444. Printed reports will be maintained by monitors as needed in the Weapon System Application Group but are always available on the WSDB in their respective fields. The current records will also be retained as backup and reference source data for the RCS DLA(M)516(O) Report IAW individual report retention policies.

d. The data compiled from analysis of various reports should be retained and utilized as source data by the monitors. Reports may be destroyed after IAW disposition procedures whenever the DLA Form 516 reports are destroyed.
