WEAPON SYSTEM MONTHLY ANALYSIS REPORT -  
PARTS A, B, C, AND D

1. PURPOSE

This appendix is applicable to chapter 51 and provides instructions for review of appendices F-140A, F-140B, F-140C, and F-140D. This review and analysis is to determine impact and maintain visibility of All WS1 Submissions to System, WS1s Processed Against Each WSDC, All WS3 Rejects By System, and All WS3 Rejects Summary.

4. PROCEDURES/INSTRUCTIONS

- a. The WS monitor will request copies of appendices F-140A, F-140B, F-140C, and F-140D via the WSDB process.
- b. These reports are to be reviewed and analyzed for utilization of information developed in preparation of monthly RCS DLA(M) 516(O) Report for DLSC-CSS as required. The monitor will also obtain any additional information from the IMs as required.

c. The reports should be retained by the monitor for reference, research, and source purposes, keeping in mind the retention criteria for formatted reports in the WSDB. The identification of various actions, along with transaction dates, provide a documented record of Weapon System Item Files development and source data base of information for response to external and internal inquiries and reports.
