SPECIAL PHASED DUE-IN LISTING

1. PURPOSE

This report is generated when an SSCS is to be produced but there are more than 22 print lines of dues-in for that particular NSN.

4. PROCEDURES/INSTRUCTIONS

a. Occasionally, a condition will occur that there are more dues-in for an item than there are lines on an SSCS. If the large number of due-in lines is the reason an overflow SSCS is to be produced, or if an overflow SSCS is produced for some other reason and there are more than 22 print lines due-in, an F-439 Special Phased Due-In Listing, will be output by NSN to the ORC of record.

b. Dues-in will be phased into categories by comparing the current SSCS date with the Estimated Delivery Date (EDD) in the Due-In File Record. Materiel can then be classified as being due-in during the current month, overdue, or due-in during each of the six or more subsequent months.

c. The IM will review the F-439 printout and:

(1) Expedite delivery on overdue materiel.

(2) Compare current due-in with future requirement to determine potential stock excess.

d. Close liaison with the Directorate of Contracting and Production and activities that are returning materiel via customer return may be necessary to determine status of particular lines due-in.

e. Special Phased Due-In Listing, appendix F-439 will be maintained as an attachment to the associated SSCS. Retain IAW local procedures and retire IAW DLA Files Maintenance and Disposition Manual, DLAM 5015.1.
