FOREWORD

(Supplementation is permitted at all levels.)

The SAMMS Technical and Logistics Personal Computer (PC) Data Entry Users Manual contains the procedures regarding the loading, controlling, and input/upload processes of internal/external subsystem transactions. After transaction input, authorized personnel are able to upload the input data to the mainframe for further batch processing or exit.

The manual is divided into seven chapters, as follows: (1) Item Standardization; (2) Provisioning; (3) Policy Table Updates; (4) Document Identifier Code (DIC) YA8 Transactions; (5) Item Management Coding Transactions; (6) DIC LSS, DIC LSB Transactions; (7) Freight Transactions. Each area will provide screen displays and step-by-step user instructions. The DIC Index provides a quick reference to the DICs and the particular PC Program.

This revision contains the latest procedural changes caused by implementation of various System Change Requests (SCR) to the Standard Automated Materiel Management System (SAMMS) and incorporates them in the July 2000 publication of the Defense Logistics Agency Publication System (DLAPS). All changes are indicated by bold and italicized type.

Warmline USWC00-046-02, Freight Dropping Position on .dat File: This change was requested under the Defense Supply Center Columbus SAMMS Data Base Support Order to facilitate processing in the NT environment. This updated documentation is for the new PC Windows version of the Freight Input Transaction Personal Computer (FITPC), which replaced the PC-NFS and On-Net versions. The new PC version is to provide a current updated method for data input and to generate freight (Segment G) transactions for updating the Federal Logistics Information System (FLIS) Total Item Record (TIR). Corrections were also made to the data set naming convention.
