
I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet, 30 December 1982, subject: Transfer of DAASO to DLA-Z.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 16 January 1983, the management, direction, and control of the Defense Automatic Addressing System Office (DAASO) to include the International Logistics Communication System (ILCS) currently assigned to the Defense Logistics Standard Systems Office (DLSSO), Office of Plans, Policies and Programs (DLA-L), as a Management Support Activity (MSA) is transferred to the Information Systems Division, Office of Telecommunications and Information Systems (DLA-ZS), as an MSA.

III. The Chief, DAASO, reporting directly to the Chief, Information Systems Division (DLA-ZS), is responsible for the design, development, test, implementation, and maintenance of the Defense Automatic Addressing System (DAAS). DAASO will continue to provide telecommunications support to the Defense Electronics Supply Center (DESC) and Defense Depot Tracy (DDTC). In addition, DAASO will continue to operate and maintain the following under the technical direction of DLSSO: The Defense European and Pacific Redistribution Activity (DEPRA); the Military Supply and Transportation Evaluation Procedures (MILSTEP) Central Data Collection Point; and the DoD Activity Address Directory (DoDAAD), the Military Assistance Program Address Directory (MAPAD), and the Military Standard Requisitioning and Issue Procedures (MILSTRIP) Routing Identifier Codes.

IV. Administrative support for the DAASO which is located at Gentile AFS, Dayton, Ohio, and Tracy, California, will continue to be provided by DESC and DDTC, respectively.
