- I. Reference DLA General Order No. 6-81, 14 May 81.
- II. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 8 Feb 84, subject: Legislative and Public Affairs.
- III. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 26 Feb 84, the Office of Legislative and Public Affairs (DLA-B) is disestablished and its missions and functions are realigned as follows:
  - A. Policy and operational aspects of DLA legislative/congressional responsibilities are assigned to the Office of Congressional Affairs (DLA-Y).
  - B. Policy aspects of DLA Public Affairs Program and speech writing responsibilities are assigned to the Office of Public Affairs (DLA-B).
  - C. Operational aspects of the DLA Public Affairs Program, including responsibility for developing, preparing, coordinating and the dissemination of information to the public and publication of the official DLA magazine and various information publications, are assigned to the Technical Presentations Division, DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC-T).
- IV. DLA General Order No. 6-81, 14 May 81, is rescinded.
