I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 22 Jun 1984, subject: Realignment of the Directorate of Technical and Logistics Services.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 1 July 1984, the Directorate of Technical and Logistics Services (DLA-S) is realigned as follows:

A. The Property Disposal Division (DLA-SM) is redesignated as the Property Utilization and Disposal Division.

B. The Utilization Division (DLA-SI) is disestablished. Associated resources, mission and functions are realigned and consolidated with the Utilization and Disposal Policies Branch (DLA-SMP), Property Utilization and Disposal Division.

C. The Disposal Environmental Policy Branch (DLA-SME) is redesignated as the Environmental Disposal Policy Branch.

D. The Office of Programs and Analysis is redesignated as the Technical Programs and Administrative Office to provide centralized management and administrative support to the Executive Director and other directorate managers. Program management responsibility is realigned from the Office of Programs and Analysis (DLA-SP) to the functional division managers.

E. The Cataloging and Technical Information Division (DLA-SC) is redesignated as the Technical and Logistics Data Division.

F. The Cataloging Branch (DLA-SCC) is redesignated as the Logistics Data Branch.

G. The Technical Data Information Branch (DLA-SCT) is redesignated as the Technical Data Branch.

III. Administrative support for DLA-S will continue to be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center.
