
I. Authority: Assistant Secretary of Defense (Manpower, Installations and Logistics) Memorandum, 21 June 1985, and DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 12 July 1985, subject: Defense Spares Initiatives Office (DSIO).

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 14 July 1985, the Defense Spares Initiatives Office (DSIO), an Assistant Secretary of Defense (Acquisition and Logistics) Management Support Activity (MSA) is established with two divisions; the Program Analysis Division and the Management Systems Division. Under the general direction and support of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Spares Program Management), the Defense Spares Initiatives Office is responsible for supporting the development, implementation and management of the DoD Spares Management Improvement Program (SMIP). The Program Analysis Division is responsible for performing studies and analyses of spares procurement and management issues as directed by the DASD (SPM). The Management Systems Division is responsible for performing system development functions to improve management systems responsiveness to evolving SMIP requirements, for SMIP data, and interface with the Military Departments.

III. General Order No. 25-85, dated 18 July 1985, is superseded.

IV. Administrative support to DSIO will be provided by the Commander, DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC).
