I. Authority: Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Logistics and Materiel Management) Memorandum, 16 May 1986, subject: Enhancing the Defense Spares Initiatives Office (DSIO) and DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 27 May 86, subject: Establishment of Logistics Systems Modernization Division.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 15 June 1986, the mission of the Defense Spares Initiatives Office (DSIO), an Assistant Secretary of Defense (Acquisition and Logistics) (ASD(A&L)) Management Support Activity (MSA) is expanded. Accordingly, under the program accountability of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Logistics and Materiel Management) and with performance accountability to the Director, Spares Program Management (SPM), the Defense Spares Initiatives Office (DSIO) is expanded from two to three divisions; the Program Analysis Division, Management Systems Division, and the Logistics Systems Modernization Division.

III. The Defense Spares Initiatives Office is responsible for supporting the development, implementation and management of the DoD Spares Management Improvement Program (SMIP) and for the integration and program management of the modernization of logistics management systems. The Program Analysis Division is responsible for performing studies and analyses of spares procurement and management issues as directed by the Director (SPM). The Management Systems Division is responsible for performing system development functions to improve management systems responsiveness to evolving SMIP requirements, for SMIP data analysis, and interface with the Military Departments. The Logistics Systems Modernization Division is responsible for overseeing program planning for the integration of all forms of logistics systems and data to provide for a fully coordinated DoD program.

IV. General Order No. 42-85, dated 18 July 1985, is revoked.

V. Administrative support to DSIO will continue to be provided by the Commander, DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC).
