I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 29 Jul 1987, subject: Defense Environmental Leadership Project Office (DELPO) Restructuring.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 2 August 1987, DELPO, an OSD Management Support Activity with program and performance accountability to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Environment), DASD(E), is redesignated the Defense Environmental Management Support Activity (DEMSA) with a three division structure: Environmental Engineering, Environmental Restoration, and Environmental Waste Management. The DEMSA mission is to provide analysis, development, planning, management, coordination, implementation and evaluation of world-wide DoD environmental programs. DEMSA is an OSD Management Support Activity with program and performance accountability to DASD(E).

III. The divisions are responsible as follows:

A. The Environmental Engineering Division establishes policy and coordinates tri-services positions in complying with Congressional mandates such as the Clean Air Act and Clean Water Act, the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and directs DoD Natural Resources Conservation Programs.


B. The Environmental Restoration Division directs and manages the Defense Environmental Restoration Program (DERP) and the Defense Environmental Restoration Account (DERA).

C. The Environmental Waste Management Division serves as the central DoD source for interpretation and policy guidance for hazardous waste laws.

IV. General Order 19-85, dated 13 May 1985, is rescinded.

V. Administrative support for DEMSA will continue to be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC).
