**GENERAL ORDER

**I. Authority: Assistant Secretary of Defense (Production and Logistics) memorandum, dated 21 November 1988, subject: Reorganization of Management Support Activities.**

**II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 4 December 1988, the Defense Installation Management Center (DIMC), an OSD Management Support Activity with program and performance accountability to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Installations) (DASD(I)), is redesignated and realigned as the Defense Installations Support Office (DISO) with a four division structure: Installations Support, Installation Assistance-East, Installation Assistance-West, and Base Closure and Utilization. DISO remains under the program and performance accountability of the DASD(I). The DISO mission is to:**

**a. Act as principal advisor to the DASD(I) for installation management and base closure/utilization matters.**

**b. Promote increased readiness through installation and total quality management.**

**III. The divisions are responsible as follows:**

**a. The Installations Support Division administers OSD policies and guidance for the DoD Model Installation Program (MIP), Graduate Program, Shelter for the Homeless Program, the Unified Budget Program, the DoD Commercial Activities (CA) Program, privatization of government services, improved service contracting, Private Sector Financing, and DoD quality service programs.**

**b. The Installation Assistance-East Division provides assistance to installations in the European Theater and east of the Mississippi River concerning all programs within the ODASD(I).**

**c. The Installation Assistance-West Division provides assistance to installations in the Pacific Theater and west of the Mississippi River concerning all programs within the ODASD(I).**

**d. The Base Closure and Utilization Division administers OSD policies and guidance for matters pertaining to base closures and alternate uses of DoD facilities.**

**IV. General Order 1-88, dated 5 January 1988, is rescinded.**
