GENERAL ORDER
NO. 4-89

I. Authority: DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet approved 16 February 1989, subject: Request for Realignment of Directorate of Quality Assurance.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 19 February 1989, the Directorate of Quality Assurance is realigned as follows:

A. The Quality Engineering and Computer Software Management Division (DLA-QE) with Quality Engineering Management (DLA-QEL) and Computer Software Management (DLA-QES) Branches is established.

B. The Product Quality Management Division (DLA-QP) with Branch A (DLA-QPA) and Branch B (DLA-QPB) is established.

C. The Total Quality Management Office (DLA-QT) is established. This office is authorized only until 31 December 1992. A reevaluation of the requirements for the office will be performed before that date and a proposal made as to its future status.

D. The Engineering and Technical Management Division (DLA-QE) is disestablished.

E. The Product Quality Assessment Office (DLA-QO) is disestablished.

F. The Clothing and Textiles QA Office (DLA-QM) is disestablished.

III. The newly established organizational elements will have basic responsibilities as follows:

A. Quality Engineering and Computer Software Division will have primary responsibility for DLA Quality policies, programs, systems, and procedures for quality engineering in contracts assigned for administration including computer software requirements and products. It will include administration of the Product Quality Deficiency Report Management System.

1. Quality Engineering Management Branch provides engineering and technical staff support in the areas of QA and assigned engineering and commodity functions and administers the Product Quality Deficiency Report Management System.

2. Computer Software Management Branch provides staff support and guidance to DCASR QA elements in the review and evaluation of contract computer software requirements and contractor compliance to the requirements.

B. Product Quality Management Division will have primary responsibility for DLA Quality policies, programs, and systems for assigned high visibility or critical commodity areas and provide technical guidance and support for the application of skills and discipline in assigned commodity areas.


1. Branch A will exercise such responsibilities for the major commodity areas of nuclear, Level I/Subsafe, Ammunition, and wheeled vehicles.

2. Branch B will exercise such responsibilities for the major commodity areas of clothing and textiles, petroleum, and general products.

C. Total Quality Management Office will administer the development, integration, coordination and monitoring of the DLA Total Quality Management Plan.

IV. Administrative support will continue to be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center.
