GENERAL ORDER  
NO. 30-90

I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-L Staff Summary Sheet, dated 12 September 1990, subject: Establishment of Defense Contract Management Command International (DCMCI).

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 1 October 1990, the Air Force Contract Maintenance Center, less its Directorate of Contract Management, is transferred to the Defense Contract Management Command, DLA, from the Air Force Logistics Command. The activity, reporting directly to the Commander, DCMC, is designated as the Defense Contract Management Command International (DCMCI) and will remain at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio.

III. The Commander, DCMCI, is responsible for providing management direction and control over contract management functions at contractor plants and government installations and in geographic areas around the world. Ensures economical, effective and efficient administration of modification and programmed depot maintenance contracts, new production contracts, foreign military sales contracts, and other contracts in assigned plants and areas. The DCMCI, in addition to the Commander and Deputies, consists of the following subordinate elements:

A. Assistant to the Commander for Safety (DCMCI-QS) is responsible for providing information to the Commander, DCMCI, on all safety related matters and serves as the activity point of contact for all safety matters and coordination of safety actions.

B. Assistant to the Commander for Quality (DCMCI-QP) is responsible for providing information on current Total Quality Management (TQM) information and for providing cross-feed TQM information between DCMCI and DCMC.

C. Office of Information Management (DCMCI-I) is responsible for issuing guidance and exercising control over administrative programs for DCMCI and its subordinate activities; for publications and forms management programs including editing, publishing and distribution of activity publications; serves as the activity security officer for receipt, storage and control of classified material; for maintenance of a functional publications library; and for maintaining liaison with DCMC and DLA counterparts.

D. Office of Contracting Policy (DCMCI-T) is responsible for interpreting higher-level policy, development of implementation of procedures, maintaining surveillance over subordinate DCMCI activities, and for development of policies not specifically covered by DLA/DCMC.

E. Directorate of Resource Management (DCMCI-R) is responsible for providing staff assistance and oversight of management information systems, program analysis, budget, financial requirements and contingency planning exercise activities; and for overseeing manpower, personnel, industrial preparedness planning and data automation programs. The Directorate consists of the following subordinate elements:

1. Manpower and Resources Division (DCMCI-RM) which serves as the focal point for all manpower, personnel, and financial matters.

2. Plans and Programs Division (DCMCI-RX) which maintains visibility over potential workload and performs short- and long-term planning.

F. Directorate of Production, Maintenance, and Materiel (DCMCI-P) is responsible for providing staff assistance to manufacturing management, industrial property administration and transportation activities in DCMCI subordinate activities; and for analyzing major problems, technical deficiencies, and proposed improvements for manufacturing, industrial property and transportation.

G. Directorate of Quality Assurance, Flight Test, and Safety (DCMCI-Q) is responsible for interpreting policy, developing procedures, and maintaining surveillance of all DCMDI quality assurance, flight test, and safety activities.

H. The subordinate DCMCI activities, transferred from Army, Navy, Air Force and DCMD Mid-Atlantic, consisting of the Defense Contract Management Area Operations, Defense Contract Management Offices and residencies listed at Enclosure 1 are responsible for performing contract administration functions defined in the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR), Part 42.

IV. Administrative support for the DCMCI and its subordinate activities will be provided in accordance with Interservice Support Agreements negotiated for that purpose.
