GENERAL ORDER
NO. 35-90

I. Authority: DLA-D approval of Staff Summary Sheet 10 September 1990, subject: Realignment of Existing Organizations in the Office of Command Security (DLA-I).

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective immediately, the organizational realignment in the Office of Command Security (DLA-I) is as follows:

A. The DLA Command Security Support Office (DCSO), as a Management Support Activity (MSA), is disestablished. The mission, functions, and staffing formerly assigned to DCSO are transferred to DLA-I's five new divisions. The new divisions of DLA-I will be as follows:

1. DLA-IA, ADP and Communications Security Division
2. DLA-IC, Criminal Investigations Division
3. DLA-II, Intelligence and Security Division
4. DLA-IP, Physical Security and Law Enforcement Division
5. DLA-IO, Security Operations Division

III. The realignment of DLA-I and the absorption of DCSO into Headquarters Staff is in response to a decision by the Director, DLA, to eliminate MSAs which do not conform to current OSD guidance and to reduce the number of MSAs in DLA.

IV. Administrative support will be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC).
