GENERAL ORDER  
NO. 07-91

- I. Authority: DCMC-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 27 February 1991, subject: Defense Contract Management Command International (DCMCI).
- II. On 1 October 1990, DCMCI was established as a region level field activity of the Defense Contract Management Command (DCMC), reporting directly to the Commander, DCMC and was located at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio. The Commander, DCMCI, is responsible for providing management direction and control over contract management functions at contractor plants and government installations and in geographic areas around the world. Ensures economical, effective and efficient administration of modification and programmed depot maintenance contracts, new production contracts, foreign military sales contracts, and other contracts in assigned plants and areas.
- III. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 1 March 1991, the DCMCI organization is modified as follows:
- A. The Commander's Personal Staff is established which consists of the following:
    - 1. Command Security Officer (DCMCI-DS) who is responsible for implementation of DCMCI programs relating to physical security and law enforcement, including the product security program and for liaison with other security organizations supporting DCMCI.
    - 2. Internal Review Officer (DCMCI-DI) who is responsible for administering the Internal Review Program.
  - B. The Personnel Support Office is established and is responsible for military personnel management matters and civilian personnel support programs.
  - C. The Office of Planning, Resources, and Information Management (DCMCI-M) is established and is responsible for implementing financial management policy, strategic and contingency planning, facilities management, internal controls, information resources management/ telecommunications, mission and organization, international logistics, and common administrative services. The office will consist of a Program Budget and Information Management Division and a Plans, Organization and Administration Management Division.
  - D. The Office of Counsel (DCMCI-G) is established and is responsible for providing legal advice and services to DCMCI on matters involving or affecting the activity.
  - E. The Directorate of Contract Management (DCMCI-A) is established and is responsible for contract administration, evaluation and negotiation; cost/price and financial analysis; contractor system reviews; production surveillance and industrial resources' preparedness planning; property management; transportation; and contract termination settlement.

F. The Directorate of Quality Assurance (DCMCI-Q) is established and is responsible for implementation and oversight of the DCMC Quality Assurance Program, Flight Operations, Specialized Safety and Total Quality Management within DCMCI.

G. The Directorate of Program and Technical Support (DCMCI-E) is established and is responsible for surveillance of contractor engineering and manufacturing systems and efforts, analysis of contractor generated engineering and technical proposals and reports, and program management support of defense weapon systems and critical Government programs, and program, manufacturing, and engineering surveillance of foreign military sales/coproduction.

H. The Assistant to the Commander for Safety (DCMCI-QS), the Assistant to the Commander for Quality (DCMCI-QP), the Office of Information Management (DCMCI-I), the Office of Contracting Policy (DCMCI-T), the Directorate of Resource Management (DCMCI-R), and the Directorate of Production, Maintenance, and Materiel (DCMCI-P) and the Directorate of Quality Assurance, Flight Test, and Safety (DCMCI-Q) are disestablished and their resources are transferred to the above newly created organizational elements.

I. The subordinate DCMCI activities consisting of the Defense Contract Management Area Operations and their subordinate Defense Contract Management Offices and residencies are listed at Enclosure 1 and are responsible for performing contract administration functions defined in the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR), Part 42. IV. DLA General Order No. 30-90, dated 18 September 1990, is rescinded.

IV. Administrative support for the DCMCI and its subordinate activities will continue to be provided in accordance with Interservice Support Agreements negotiated for that purpose.
