GENERAL ORDER
NO. 19-98

I. Authority: Program Budget Decision No. 711-R dated December 17, 1997, and DoD Reform Initiative Directive #19 dated January 14, 1998, subject: Transfer of the Defense Property Accountability System to the Defense Logistics Agency.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective August 2, 1998, responsibility for the oversight, control, and management of the day-to-day operations of the Defense Property Accountability System (DPAS) transfers from the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller) (OUSDC) to DLA. Resources for the balance of fiscal year 98 will be reimbursed from OUSDC. The DPAS is established as a Business Support Unit of the DLA Comptroller (FO).

III. The DPAS is the DoD migratory system for which DLA is the Executive Agent. It is an automated system for improving accounting and accountability for DoD-owned property.

IV. The Defense Automated Printing and Support Center (DAPSC) will provide DPAS administrative support.
