SUBJECT: Editorial Changes to the Joint Travel Regulation (JTR):
Contract Airline City Pairs, Per Diem for Trainees at PDS
Area and Alaska Ferry Issues

The JTR, Chapter 2, par. C2001-A2a is revised on the use of discount fares offered by contract air carriers between certain cities (city-pairs) is advantageous to the Government and is mandatory for authorized air travel between those city-pairs; see Title 41, Code of Federal Regulations (Federal Travel Regulation (FTR)), Section 301-10.107 (JTR, par. C6006 contains an edited extract from DoD 4500. 9-R, Part I, Chapter 103, paras. A2 and E concerning DOD regulations and FAQs applicable to the Contract City Pairs Program). These revisions should appear in JTR change no. 404, effective 1 June 1999. (enclosure 1)

JTR, par. C4552-F, Per Diem for Trainees at a PDS area was removed and rewritten into JTR, par. C 1060 by CAP Item 15-98-Reimbursement for Training at PDS (Ch. 400, 1 Feb 99). The current JTR version, par. C455 2-C contains a reference to the previous "subpar. F" that was in place before the Feb 1, 1999 change. Par. C4552-D contains a reference to the previous "subpar. G". The editorial updates both cross-references and JTR, paras. C4552-C and C4552-D. (enclosure 2)
