SUBJECT: Y2K Worldwide Notice – Public Announcement from State Department

The U.S. Department of State provided a public announcement (attached) for overseas travelers regarding anticipated Year 2000 (Y2K) computer problems.

The State Department is warning those who travel in overseas locations before and during January 1, 2000, that transportation, financial, utility, telecommunication and vital services may be disrupted as a result of Y2K problems.

The overseas resources that could be affected are: transportation systems, medical facilities, and financial institutions (including credit cards and ATM machines).
