FOREIGN ACQUISITION

SUBPART 25.70 - AUTHORIZATION ACTS, APPROPRIATIONS ACTS, AND
OTHER STATUTORY RESTRICTIONS ON FOREIGN PURCHASES

25.7002 Restriction on food, clothing, fabrics, specialty metals, and hand or measuring tools.

25.7002-2 Exceptions.

(b) Each activity that has been granted a domestic non-availability determination (DNAD) is required to annually report 1) results of market research to find domestic sources that would preclude the continuing need for the DNAD; 2) results of specification reviews with requiring activities in order to find acceptable substitute products that would not require a DNAD; and 3) results of any additional requirements specified in the DNAD approval. The first submission is due to J-3312 on December 31, 2003.
