LESO Compliance Reviews

- **Conducted by DLA LESO to all participating states and territories over a projected 24-month period**
- **Intent is to review compliance with the terms and conditions outlined in the MOA between the state/territory and DLA**
- **Formal In/Out Briefs conducted by the LESO Team to the State Coordinator**
- **Review uses a checklist format (dated 24 Jan 01)**





LESO Compliance Reviews

- **Within 30 days of the visit, a formal LESO findings document is sent to the State Coordinator. We request a corrective actions response from the state/territory within 30-45 days of receipt**
- **Records Maintenance:**
 - **Consult your State Auditing Activity for specific general records maintenance requirements (varies by state)**
 - **Special Categories (i.e., DEMIL, MLI, CCLI, aircraft, weapons) require records be maintained as long as that item is in use until disposed of or transferred**






DoD Exclusive Screening and GSA's XcessXpress Initiative

- **Re-implementation of DoD Exclusive Screening**
- **All DoD and 12 Special Property Program Customers (of which 1033 is a part) enjoy upfront screening of property during 7 days of accumulation and 14 days of formal screening for up to 21 days of exclusive screening**
- **Following the formal screening period, DRMS reports the remaining property to GSA for screening under their XcessXpress compressed screening initiative**
- **GSA XcessXpress screening customers include DoD, Federal and Donation**
- **New screening policy effective 22 April 02**




Current & New Screening Cycle Timelines

Support to First Response Efforts

- **Attacks on WTC, New York City – Over \$1 million in 1033 property from contributing states/agencies (GA, NC, SC, NLECTC) as well as DLA LESO approved requests**
- **Noble, GA – Georgia Dept of Public Safety sent initial support push of individual items worth over \$42,000**
- **Other LEA Success Stories – Charleston PD heavily supports emergency response efforts along eastern seaboard as an example**
- **Emerging Homeland Security Policy – 1033 Program already provides support to counter-terrorism, counter-drug and general law enforcement missions**

DLA 1122 Program

- **The 1994 National Defense Authorization Act authorizes state and local governments to purchase law enforcement equipment suitable for use for counterdrug activities through the Federal Government. Each participating state has a State Point of Contact (SPOC) for this program.**
- **Sources of supply include DLA, GSA, Dept of Army**
- **DLA provides support thru Inventory Control Points (ICPs):**
 - **Defense Supply Center Columbus (item categories S9C/S9E) Provides items that include: spare parts for aircraft; holsters and gun parts; automotive parts; electronic items such as ADP equipment; video recording; television surveillance monitors; testing equipment; telephone equipment.**
 - **Defense Supply Center Richmond (S9G) - Provides items that include: safety and rescue equipment; riot control; alarm and security detection systems; aircraft repair parts; batteries; motor oil**



DLA 1122 Program

- Defense Supply Center Philadelphia (S9M/S9T) - Provides medical items such as first aid kits, search and rescue kits; clothing items such as uniforms; individual equipment such as helmets, body armor, tentage, water storage bags; and subsistence items like combat meals ready-to-eat.
- Defense Energy Support Center - Offers bulk fuel into-plane contracts for refueling at commercial airports.
- DLA items are identified by name (nomenclature) and national stock number. A stock number is needed to order an item.
