DRMS & Xcess Xpress

- **Xcess Xpress Combines FEDs, Donation Eligible, and DoD screening from two 21 day screening cycles to one 21 day screening cycle.**
- **GSA will have allocation authority and will allocate, for the most part, on a first come first serve basis.**
- **DoD and special programs have a 14-day exclusive screening timeframe prior to property being passed to GSA's Xcess Xpress.**



What's Changed?

- **DRMS will standardize the accumulation timeframe to 7 Days.**
- **DoD and Special Programs will have a 14 Day exclusive screening timeframe. Assets will be visible the day the property enters inventory, which could be 7 days before the 14 day screening begins.**
- **During the 21 day Xcess Xpress screening, currently, all agencies including DoD will have to register an account with GSA and submit a request for property and await allocation notice.**



What's Changed?

- **Exceptions: Priority 1-3, and non-mission capable supply requisitions can be submitted through DRMS during 21 Day Xcess Xpress.**
- **For DoD customers all assets will be visible on the DRMS web page. However, property that is in the Xcess Xpress phase must be requisitioned through GSA.**
- **DoD walk-in customers will not be able to remove property without GSA authorization.**



Mitigating Potential Unfulfilled Reutilization Request

- **Computerized want list**
 - **DRMS Assets are visible on the first day after they are put on record.**
 - **Want list queries search DRMS inventory by NIIN and Condition code of your choice.**
 - **Frequency: as often as you like.**
 - **Results are emailed to your POC or placed on DRMS server to be downloaded as .zip file.**
