SUBJECT: Migration to the Defense Logistics Management System (DLMS) and Elimination of the Military Standard Systems (MILS)

On December 22, 2003, the Acting Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics (USD AT&L) released a memorandum (attached) that directs actions to accelerate the Integrated Logistics Enterprise (ILE). The memo directs the migration to the DLMS and restricts the use of MILS in any new logistics system investment programs. Additionally, the memo directs Military Departments, USTRANSCOM, and Defense Agencies to submit their final plans for migration of their systems to the DLMS, elimination of the MILS, and incorporation of the UID in application system databases by April 16, 2004. These plans are to be submitted to the Director, Defense Logistics Management Standards Office (DLMSO).

We support the efforts of DLMSO and they look forward to partnering with you. Your collaboration with them is crucial in order to ensure that your systems are in compliance with the technical standards and requirements described in the USD AT&L policy. This will help ensure consistency throughout the Department.
