
MEMORANDUM FOR: SUPPLY PRC MEMBERS

SUBJECT: Approved DLMS Change 48, Revisions to DLMS Supplements:
Material Release Order and Material Release Advice (Supply/MILSTRIP)

This change to the DoD 4000.25-M, Defense Logistics Management System (DLMS), revises the DLMS Supplements 940R, Material Release Order, and 945A, Material Release Advice. This change reflects numerous changes requested during the Supply Process Review Committee meetings 01-2 and 01-3. Additional changes to support continued logistics operation in a DLMS/DLSS environment were identified as a result of testing and development.

The DLMS Supplements will be posted to the DLMSO web site (<http://www.dla.mil/j-6/dlms/ICs/Default.htm>) immediately upon coordination/ approval of the governing Federal implementation conventions (ICs) from the DoD Logistics Functional Working Group (LFWG), the DoD Electronic Data Interchange Standards Management Committee (EDISMC), and the Federal EDI Standards Management Coordinating Committee (FESMCC). Additionally, the revised DSs will be provided for implementation planning on the above web site pending Federal approval. The effective date of the revised DSs for DLMS use is 30 days from the above date.

3. REQUESTED CHANGE:

a. Title: Revisions to DLMS Supplements: Material Release Order and Material Release Advice.

b. Description of Change: This change modifies the DLMS Supplement (DS) 940R Material Release and DS 945A Material Release Advice to provide administrative corrections, clarifications, and additional coding to support lateral redistribution orders/responses.

c. Procedures: Changes identified by bold/italics or as noted. Revise DLMS Supplements as follows. All of the following revisions are supported by policy and are consistent with the framework of the Federal IC unless otherwise noted.

d. **Alternatives:** None identified.

4. **REASON FOR CHANGE:** This change supports DLMS implementation and desired functionality. The above changes were identified during Supply PRC 01-2 and 01-3 meeting review. It was determined that currently published DLMS Supplements did not provide full identification of data fields and notes supporting LRO and LRO response. Additional administrative corrections were also identified during the review.

5. **ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:**

a. **Advantages:** Supports DLMS implementation.

b. **Disadvantages:** None identified.

6. IMPACT:

a. Publications. Federal Implementation Conventions 940R and 945A and corresponding DoD 4000.25-M DLMS Supplements. With the exception of the 2/G62 revisions and the addition of 945 A, 1/W0611/20, Code DS, all of the above changes can be published immediately within the DLMS Supplement upon release of the approved change. The G62 and W0611 revisions require prior change to the Federal Implementation Convention (IC). All applicable revisions will submitted to the Federal IC

b. DAAS DLMS/DLSS conversion maps will must be modified to incorporate above revisions.
