
MEMORANDUM FOR: SUPPLY PROCESS REVIEW COMMITTEE (PRC) MEMBERS

SUBJECT: Proposed DLMS Change 103, Revised Service Code V Use (Supply/
MILSTRIP)

Proposed DLMS Change 103 Revised Service Code V Use

1. ORIGINATOR:

- a. **Service/Agency:** Navy, Naval Inventory Control Point

2. FUNCTIONAL AREA:

Primary: Supply Military Standard Requisitioning and Issue Procedures (MILSTRIP)

3. REQUESTED CHANGE:

- a. **Title:** Revised Service Code V Use
- b. **Description of Change:** This change proposes reassigning the use of Service Code V, in record positions (rp) 4, 67, and 74 to the Navy. V is currently assigned to NASA in rp 4 and is currently unassigned in rp 67 and 74. Rp 4, 67, and 74 designate the start of the Routing Identifier (RI) field in MILSTRIP and MILSTRAP logistics transactions.
- c. **Procedures:** Revise appendix DOD 4000.25M MILSTRIP, AP2.2, Service and Agency Codes as follows:

4. REASON FOR CHANGE: Contractors transmit, receive, and process 80 rp MILSTRIP and MILSTRAP transactions in logistical support of the Navy and use RIs to identify their facilities. The Navy requires the capability to distinguish Navy military activities from Navy contractors. Q-series RIs, currently used to distinguish Navy contractor RIs, will soon be exhausted; assignment of V Service Code to Navy in rp 4, 67, and 74 will assist Navy to meet increasing ongoing requirements

to provide a unique RI to contractors supporting the Navy. Navy contractors will continue to use Service Code Q in rp 30 and 45.

5. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

a. Advantages: Navy will be able to meet increasing requirements to assign RIs to the facilities of Commercial Asset Visibility (CAV) and Performance Based Logistics (PBL) contractors. PBL is the Navy's rendition of Direct Vendor Delivery, i.e., where the contractor is managing all or part of the supply chain.

b. Disadvantages: None identified other than NASA has eleven V-series RICs that will need to be reassigned. NASA has agreed to dispense with V-series RIs and reassign them to General Service Agency (GSA) RIs.

6. IMPACT:

a. Programming: Minor programming changes/table edits at DAAS to identify Navy Unique B-series transactions and recognize V-series RIs as Navy contractors. Minor programming changes may be needed at ICPs to recognize V-series RI as Navy contractors.

b. Planned Implementation: The Navy will maximize the lead time for Component implementation by exhausting the Q-series RI assignments prior to issuing the V-series. Navy will notify Components through the Supply PRC when V-series assignments are to begin.
