
**PERSONNEL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)**

SECTION A. This Procedure is under the terms of the DLA-AFGE Master Labor Agreement, Article 15, Section 2. The Procedure supersedes former provisions of the DSCC-AFGE Local 1148 Supplement to the DLA-AFGE Master Labor Agreement.

SECTION B. Protective clothing will be provided by the employer for the protection of employees from injury and disease whenever such protection is deemed necessary by the DES-C Safety and Health Officer or designee.

SECTION C. Further provisions may later be negotiated on how PPE will be furnished for the Pandemic Flu or other major health epidemic.
