

F-15C Eagle aircraft flying in support of military deployments consume fuel and rely on spare parts provided by DLA.




Living containers are placed on prepared foundations on Hill 722 in Bosnia. Defense Contract Management Command (DCMC) administers contracts in support of deployments around the world.

The massive job of outfitting an aircraft carrier for deployment relies on support from across DLA.




Deployment of Abrams tanks and other Army vehicles in Bosnia-Herzegovina depend on fuel, food and spare parts supplied by DLA.
