DLA Aviation supports more than 13,500 joint aircraft, 450 intercontinental ballistic missiles and a host of other weapons systems. The activity is the U.S. military's integrated material manager for more than 1.8 million national stock number items, industrial retail supply and depotlevel reparable acquisitions.
