U.S. Statistics

- 1 in 44 children is diagnosed with ASD.
- 2% of adults are estimated to have ASD.
- Boys are four times more likely to be diagnosed with ASD than girls.
- ASD affects all ethnic and socioeconomic groups.

Symptoms

- Difficulties reading and understanding social cues
- Sensitivity to sensory stimulation, which can lead to meltdowns or tantrums
- Delayed developmental learning and challenges in the classroom setting
