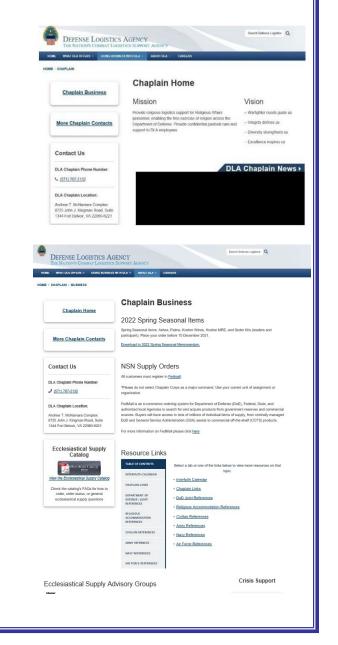

How to Order



1. <u>Login</u>/Register at Procurement Integrated Enterprise Environment (PIEE) https://piee.eb.mil/

- 2. Login/Register for **FEDMALL** at https://www.fedmall.mil/.
- 3. Add shipping <u>addresses</u> that suits your needs:
 - -click "Admin"
 - -click "My Account"
 - then click "Address Book"
- 4. Build your shopping cart:
 - -click "Shop"
 - -click "Catalog Search"
- -enter either a Keyword or Item NSN Number and click "Search."
- -find the correct item you are looking for, enter the quantity you want and click "Add."
- 5. Checkout:
- -click "Cart Summary" near the top right of your screen
- -here you can modify your cart, print the cart, send the cart to another DOD FEDMALL user, or process your order.
 - -click "Checkout"
- -select <u>Priority Code 3</u> and <u>Advice</u>

 <u>Code 2L</u> from the drop down arrows. Click
 "Next."
- -review order ensuring to change the shipping address as necessary.
- -write down the document number indicated next to the items then click "*Place Order*." You may also save the order for later, or print the order for your records.

DODAAC

Using the correct DODAAC is critical for delivery of supplies at the **RIGHT PLACE...**

The Department of Defense Address Activity Code (DODAAC) is a six position code that uniquely identifies a unit, activity or organization that has the authority to requisition and/or receive materiel.

The *Navy DODAACs* are the letter "N" followed by the five digit Unit Identification Code (UIC). *Example:* N12345

There may be up to three distinct addresses contained in the Department of Defense Activity Address Directory (DODAAD) for each DODAAC, as follows:

TAC1 - Identifies the mailing address for the activity (mandatory).

TAC2 - Identifies the 'ship to' (freight) address for the activity.

TAC3 - Identifies the billing address (The activity responsible for payment of bills.) If there is no TAC2 present, shipment will be made to the TAC1 address.

Priority Code, Advice Code, & Document

PRIORITY CODE

- Setting the MILSTRIP Priority is critical for delivery of supplies at the **RIGHT TIME...**

PRIORITY DESIGNATORS 1-3

CONUS: 8 Days OCONUS: 12-13 Days

PRIORITY DESIGNATORS 4-8CONUS: 12 Days OCONUS: 16-17 Days

PRIORITY DESIGNATORS 9-15

CONUS: 31 Days OCONUS: 69-84 Days

Priority "1" – call-in only
Priority "2" – ongoing operations only
Priority "3" – recommended

- Set the Priority Code higher or forget to make a change and you may not see your supplies for 2 MONTHS!

ADVICE CODE

- When ordering Ecclesiastical Supply Items, ALWAYS use: <u>Advice Code 2L</u>
- Failure to do so may cause your order to be deleted.

DOCUMENT NUMBER

- After placing your order, ensure to write down the *document number*.
- You will need to provide the document number in order to receive a status or track the items.
- It is very difficult to locate an order in the system without a document number.
