Administrative Approved Defense Logistics Management Standards Change 1531, Quarterly Administrative Updates

a. **Bottom Line Up Front:** The administrative updates and corrections contained within this quarterly Memorandum for Record (MFR) enhance user value by clarifying and correcting language in the Defense Logistics Manual (DLM) 4000.25 and Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS) implementation conventions (ICs). DLMS may support multiple ICs based on different versions/releases of the X12 standard dependent upon trading partner requirements. In addition, DLMS may support multiple standards of DLMS ICs within each ANSI ASC X12 version/release. Currently some transactions such as the DLMS 9471 support multiple standards; the newer (004030) version/release is used for new implementations, while enabling existing implementations to remain at an older version/release (004010), until they can be modified to the newer version/release. Older version/release DLMS ICs may not have all the functionality of the newer one, so Component AIS should plan to modernize to the newer version release (4030). Once all Component AIS have been modernized to the newer version release, DEDSO will cancel the old DLMS IC via a formally staffed DLMS change. Proposed Wording Change: C3.3.2. Multiple DLMS Versions. The Defense Logistics Management Standard supports the use of multiple ICs based on updated versions or releases of the X12. This version maintenance is also dependent upon trading partner requirements. Currently, DAAS maintains and supports multiple versions of transactions and all component related logic to ensure transaction processing remains uninterrupted. Multiple versions allow operational continuity, however, DEDSO will only maintain the most updated version of each DLMS IC on the official website. This ensures a single, authoritative reference for current implementation standards. Older versions/releases of DLMS ICs may not have all the functionality of the newest version, therefore, Component AIS should plan to modernize to the newer version release as soon as possible.
