SUBJECT: Approved DLMS Change 60A, Addendum for Revision to DLMS Supplement (DS) 180M, Material Returns Reporting (Supply)

This addendum provides a revision to the DoD 4000.25-M, Defense Logistics Management System (DLMS), modifying the DS 180M. These administrative changes were developed and approved by Components during the Supply Process Review Committee (SPRC) 02-02 meeting and will be incorporated with Approved DLMS Change 60 during implementation. These change are required to support continued logistics operations in the DLSS/DLMS environment.

The updated DLMS Supplement will be posted to the DLMSO web site (<u>http://www.dla.mil/j-6/dlmso/ICs/Default.htm</u>) within 30 days from the above date for implementation planning. DLMSO will concurrently pursue coordination/approval with the DoD Logistics Functional Working Group, the DoD Electronic Data Interchange Standards Management Committee (EDISMC), and the Federal EDI Standards Management Coordinating Committee (FESMCC) for Federal implementation conventions (IC) revisions.

4. REQUESTED CHANGE:

a. Title: Addendum for Revision to DS 180M, Material Returns Reporting

b. Description of Change: This change provides numerous administrative corrections, clarifications, and updates but does not alter the functionality of the DS 180M.

c. Procedures: Revise DS 180M, Material Returns Reporting as follows:
