Revisions to DLMS Supplement (DS) 867I Issue to Add Build Directive Number (BDN) to Support the Theater Enterprise-Wide Logistics System (TEWLS) and DS 867I Administrative Updates (Supply) (Staffed by PDC 298)

4. REQUESTED CHANGE:

a. **Title:** Revisions to DS 867I Issue to Add Build Directive Number (BDN) to Support the Theater Enterprise-Wide Logistics System (TEWLS) and DS 867I Administrative Updates (Supply)

b. **Description of Change:**

1) **DLA Change:** DLA requires visibility of the BDN in DS 867I since DLA owns the material at the TEWLS/AMMA site until the items are issued at the retail level. This change supports the medical and industrial kitting community requirements for the BDN in order to identify kitting build orders. The BDN was previously added to the following DS (DSs are available at: http://www.dla.mil/j-6/dlms0/elibrary/TransFormats/140_997.asp):

- 527D (see 2/N901/090 qualifier 'WO')
- 527R (see 2/N901/090 qualifier 'WO')
- 650A (see 1/REF01/0300 qualifier 'WO')

2) **DLMSO Administrative Updates:** While DS 867I is open for revision by this change, DLMSO has included administrative updates to the PTD segment to revise DLMS notes for the Product Transfer Type Code to show the relationship of the DLMS codes to the corresponding MILSTRAP Issue Document Identifier Code D7_ .

c. Background for DLA proposal: The Theater Enterprise Wide Logistics System (TEWLS) Army Medical Material Agreement (AMMA) process will be implemented with DLA’s Enterprise Business Systems (EBS) in FY08. DLA funds are used by the Army to purchase items via Defense Medical Logistics Standard Support (DMLSS)/TEWLS. In this case, EBS owns the materiel at the TEWLS/AMMA site until items are issued at the retail level. As a result, the DLMS 867I (for the functionality of MILSTRAP DI Code D7B) will be received by EBS from DMLSS/TEWLS, and must contain a BDN in order to identify a kitting build appropriately.

f. **Alternatives:** EBS will not be able to support the TEWLS processes using the EDI 867I without this change and will need to consider nonstandard options.

6. REASON FOR CHANGE: DLA EBS requires the BDN in DS 867I in order to process TEWLS issue transactions.

7. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

a. Advantages: EBS and TEWLS will be able to comply with DLMS standards for the TEWLS/AMMA issue processes.

b. Disadvantages: None identified.
