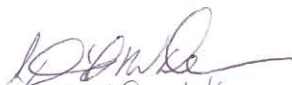

SUBJECT: Approved Defense Logistics Management System (DLMS) Change (ADC) 281, Administrative Revision to DLMS Supplement (DS) 517M, Material Obligation Validation (MOV), to Insert Missing Qualifier for Material Identification (Supply)

Administrative Revision to DLMS Supplement (DS) 517M, Material Obligation Validation (MOV), to Insert Missing Qualifier for Material Identification

1. ORIGINATOR:

a. Service/Agency: Defense Logistics Management Standards Office (DLMSO)

2. FUNCTIONAL AREA: Supply

3. REQUESTED CHANGE:

a. Description of Change: Administrative correction to include missing qualifier that identifies nonstandard material. This qualifier is necessary for conversion between MILSTRIP and DLMS.

b. Procedures: Revise DLMS Supplement 517M, Material Obligation Validation (MOV) as follows:

d. Alternatives: None known.

4. REASON FOR CHANGE: USTRANSCOM support personnel developing the Global Transportation Network Pre-Planned Product Improvement (GTN P31) interface identified a gap between the DLMS Supplement 517M and the applicable DAAS map. The mapping document says that 'part number' (in record position 8-22) is mapped to N902 with N901 = "ZZ". According to the IC, "ZZ" is not a valid value for N901 in the 517M. The developers suggested that the correct code for "part number" (according to the DS) for N901 is "MF", and that the mapping needed to be corrected to identify "MF" in N901 when rp 8-22 contains "part numbers." DAASC noted that "ZZ" must be used as the qualifier because the MILSTRIP AF1, 2, 3 gives no indication whether it's a Part Number or Other. Since the supplement didn't provide for the use of ZZ at N901, this change was required.

5. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

a. Advantages: Conforms to MILSTRIP conversion requirements.

b. Disadvantages: None identified.

6. IMPACT:

a. Modify DOD 4000.25-M DLMS Supplement 17M, MOV transaction.

b. No impact on DAAS mapping documents.

c. Data impact: Allows for identification of an additional category for materiel identification (previously undocumented in the DLMS supplement).
