Revise DLMS 846P, Response to Transaction History Request When No History Available, to Add a Second Iteration of Type Physical Inventory/ Transaction History Code (Supply)

1. ORIGINATOR:

- a. Service/Agency: Defense Logistics Agency (DLA)
- **b.** Originator: DLA HQ, J-3312, Inventory Management, DLA Joint Physical Inventory Working Group (JPIWG) representative, 703-767-1606 (DSN 427)
- 2. FUNCTIONAL AREA: Supply
- **3. REFERENCE:** DLMSO memorandum, June 6, 2006, subject: Approved DLMS Change (ADC) 198, Revise DLMS Supplement (DS) 846P to Provide Capability to Advise When No History is Available in Response to a Transaction History Request

4. REQUESTED CHANGE:

- **a. Title:** Revise DLMS 846P, Response to Transaction History Request When No History Available, to Add a Second Iteration of Type Physical Inventory/Transaction History Code
- **b. Background:** Under MILSTRAP, when there is no transaction history available for the requested timeframe, a DZK transaction history response is sent with record positions 30-43, either 8-filled or 9-filled. Under DLMS, the storage activity uses DS 846P, Response to Transaction History Request (No History Available)¹, for this purpose. When using DS 846P as a "Response to Transaction History Request (No History Available)", a Type Physical Inventory/Transaction History Code '8' or '9' is required in the 2/LQ/270 segment (LQ01 qualifier 'FC' applies). Codes '8' and '9' were added by referenced ADC 198 to capture the information conveyed by the 8 or 9-fill document number field under MILSTRAP DZK.

NOTE: There is no DLMS format designated for MILSTRAP Document Identifier (DI) Code DZK transaction history transactions themselves, when history is provided; rather history is sent back in the DLMS format of the original transaction, with a "history flag" identified as a beginning segment action code 'W1' for historical submission. Accordingly, all transactions that were subject to historical submission under MILSTRAP DZK, were given the beginning segment action code for historical submissions. DLMS transactions subject to historical submission are: 527R, 867I, 940R, 945A, 947I.

c. Description of Change:

(1) A requirement not recognized at the time ADC 198 was staffed/approved is that under current procedures, the storage activity must perpetuate the Type Physical Inventory/Transaction History Code that was conveyed on the Transaction History Request², in the history submittal, in addition to providing the ADC 198 code value '8' or '9'. Providing both the code from the request transaction and code value 8 or 9, for 846P 'Response to Transaction History Request (No History Available)' requires use of a second iteration of the LQ segment for Type Physical Inventory/Transaction History Code (LQ data element 1270 qualifier 'FC'). This change recognizes

the requirement to carry 2 Type Physical Inventory/Transaction History Codes in 846P when it is used as a "Response to Transaction History Request (No History Available)". DLA requests an optional second iteration of 2/LQ01/270 with qualifier FC which is intended be used to cite the type of transaction history code which appeared on the associated Transaction History Request, in addition to code value 8 or 9. This change modifies the 846P DLMS notes accordingly.

- (2) DLA notes that as an interim exception to policy/procedure, DLA vendor storage activities do not use Type Physical Inventory/Transaction History Codes 8 and 9 at this time. They continue to 8-fill or 9-fill the document number field, until such time as they fully implement ADC 198. This exception will be noted in the MILSTRAP Type Physical Inventory/Transaction History Code appendix.
- d. Procedures: Revise DOD 4000.25-2-M, MILSTRAP, Appendix AP2.2, Type Physical Inventory/Transaction History Code, and DLMS Data Dictionary for data element 1270 qualifier 'FC- Type Physical Inventor or Transaction History Code' to note that DLA Vendor storage activities have not yet implemented ADC 198 for use of codes '8' and '9', as shown at the enclosure. The updated appendix will be published in the next reissuance of the MILSTRAP manual.
- **e. DAASC Mapping:** DAASC mapping requirements for 846P (Response to Transaction History Request (No History Available)) (BIA02 Report Type Code AD), to MILSTRAP DZK:
- (1) When 846P, BIA02/AD, 1/LQ01/270 qualifier FC code value in LQ02 is other than 8 or 9, the LQ02 value will map to DZK, rp 7.
- (2) When 846P, BIA02/AD, 1/LQ01/270 qualifier FC code value in LQ02 is 8 or 9, value 8 or 9 will map to DZK, rp 30-43 (with rp 30-43 is 8 or 9 filled depending on LQ02 value). Code values 8 and 9 do not map to DZK rp 7.

5. REASON FOR CHANGE: To accommodate DLMS requirement for the use of two Type Physical Inventory/Transaction History Codes with 846P Response to Transaction History Request (No History Available).

6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

- **a.** Advantages: Accommodates an existing procedural requirement with DLMS capability to provide two Type Physical Inventory/Transaction History Codes through multiple iterations of the LQ segment.
 - **b. Disadvantages:** None known.
- 7. PLANNED IMPLEMENTATION DATE: Request DOD Components identify a target implementation date to DLMSO.

8. IMPACT:

- a. Publication(s): DOD 4000.25-M, DLMS and DLMS Supplement 846P.
- b. DAASC Mapping: DAASC mapping update required as documented in ADC.
- c. AUTOMATED Information Systems (AIS).
- (1) All DOD Component systems generating or receiving the DLMS 846P for "Response to Transaction History Request (No History Available)" must be able to recognize and process 2 iterations of the LQ segment for 2 Type Physical Inventory/Transaction History Code values (data element 1270 qualifier 'FC').

- (2) DLA Distribution Standard System requires this capability for a near term system release to support the year end fiscal reconciliation processing scheduled to begin August 23, 2010. There are no EBS systems changes required.
