**4. REQUESTED CHANGE(S):**

a. **Brief Overview of Change:**

(1) This change makes administrative update to DLMS, Volume 2, to add new Appendix 2.10 to capture MILSTRAP legacy transaction information. As discussed at various Supply Process Review Committee (PRC) Meetings, the DLA Logistics Management Standards Office has an ongoing initiative to incorporate the MILSTRAP manual (reference 3.a.) and the MILSTRIP manual (reference 3.b.) into the DLMS manual, Volume 2 (reference 3.c.). The current process of maintaining two sets of publications (DLMS and MILS), which contain essentially the same procedures for two different transaction formats (i.e., the Accredited Standards Committee (ASC) X12 formats and the legacy 80-record position formats), is resource intensive and duplicative in nature. This change better positions volume 2 for future movement to a combined DLMS/MILSTRAP manual.

(2) The existing DLMS Manual, Volume 2, addresses MILSTRAP legacy transactions throughout the volume, but does not specifically identify the set of MILSTRAP legacy transactions. Appendix 10 is being added to the DLMS Manual to provide the reference to the list of MILSTRAP legacy transactions.

**b. Background:** The MILSTRAP procedures are a broad base of logistics transactions and procedures designed to meet DOD requirements to establish standard codes, formats (both DLMS ASC X12 and legacy 80 record position), and procedures for inventory accountability and reporting processes. The underlying MILSTRAP procedures are detailed in the MILSTRAP Manual (legacy 80 record positions) and the DLMS Manual, Volume 2, that addresses MILSTRAP transactions using ASC X12 transactions.

**c. Revisions to DLM 4000.25 series:** Revise DLM 4000.25, Volume 2, to add Appendix 10, MILSTRAP Legacy Transactions, as shown in the enclosure.

**d. Proposed Transaction Flow:** No change to transaction flow as a result of this administrative update.

**5. REASON FOR CHANGE:** Provides a reference to the MILSTRAP legacy transactions in the DLMS Manual, Volume 2.

**6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:**

**a. Advantages:** Makes it easier for users to find the MILSTRAP legacy transactions when using the DLMS Manual, Volume 2.
