3. REFERENCE: Approved DLMS Change 1224A, Requirements for Air Force Government Furnished Property (GFP) Accountability including Identification of the Contractor Inventory Control Point (CICP), the Physical Location of Property, the Authorizing Procurement Instrument Identifier (PIID), Disposal Information in the Issue Transaction, and Enhanced Data Content in Inventory-Related Transactions (Supply/Contract Administration), April 4, 2018

4. APPROVED CHANGE(S): Substantive changes that occurred after PDC staffing are highlighted in green.

a. **Brief Overview of Change:** This change revises the DLMS 940R Materiel Release Order Implementation Convention (IC) to include a qualifier that indicates the procurement instrument identifier (PIID) applicable to the contract authorizing the contractor to manage government-owned materiel. This change supports the Air Force Government Furnished Property–Accountability (GFP-A) initiative.

b. Background:

(1) ADC 1224A added a qualifier to DLMS ICs 846P, 846R, 945A, and 947I to indicate the PIID that authorizes a contractor inventory control point (CICP) to manage government-owned property (GFP). .

(2) While implementing ADC 1224A, the Air Force noticed that both the DLMS 945A Materiel Release Confirmation and DLMS 940R Materiel Release Order included Reference Identification Qualifier CT – Contract Number. Qualifier CT indicates the PIID that authorizes GFP shipments to a contractor. However, the Air Force noted that only the materiel release confirmation contained Reference Identification Qualifier 6L–Agent Contract Number, which indicates the PIID that authorizes a contractor to manage GFP as an inventory control point. The Air Force subsequently asked EBSO if the omission of Qualifier 6L in the materiel release order was an oversight.

(3) Air Force CICPs can maintain their own warehouse management systems or use the Defense Property Accountability System (DPAS) warehouse management solution. DPAS, which is the Air Force’s accountable property system of record, does not receive materiel release orders from CICPs that maintain their own warehouse management system. However, DPAS does receive the materiel release confirmation. In either case, CICPs do not have a qualifier in the materiel release order that they can use to provide the contract number to the warehouse. Therefore, the materiel release confirmation sent from the warehouse to DPAS and the CICP cannot reference that contract number because the materiel release order did not provide it. After this revelation, the Air Force and DPAS agreed that EBSO should amend ADC 1224A to include Qualifier 6L in the DLMS 940R.

c. Approved Change in Detail: This change adds Reference Identification Qualifier 6L–Agent Contract Number to the DLMS 940R Materiel Release transaction (see the enclosure).

d. Revisions to DLM 4000.25 Manuals: None

e. Approved Transaction Flow: This change does not modify the standard MILSTRIP transaction flow.

f. Alternatives: None identified.

5. REASON FOR CHANGE: Air Force CICPs need a method to identify the contract number that authorizes the contractor to manage Air Force-owned materiel. The CICP will convey this contract number in materiel release orders, and the warehouse will convey this contract number in materiel release confirmations.

6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

a. Advantages: This change allows CICPs to reference the contract number that authorizes them to perform item management on behalf of the Federal government.

b. Disadvantages: None identified.

7. ESTIMATED TIME LINE/IMPLEMENTATION TARGET: This ADC authorizes immediate implementation.
