a. Approved DLMS Change (ADC) 1227, Update DLMS 832N Catalog Data Support Transaction to Add Catalog Data Elements for Air Force Contractor Inventory Control Point (CICP) Use under Government-Furnished Property-Accountability, June 2, 2017

b. Approved DLMS Change (ADC) 1227A, Approved Addendum to ADC 1227 to include the Moving Average Cost and Latest Acquisition Cost (Supply/Finance) (ADC 1227A), June 15, 2018

4. APPROVED CHANGE(S):

a. **Brief Overview of Change:** This approved change revises the DLMS 832N implementation convention (IC) to clarify when Air Force CICPs should use certain data elements.

b. Background:

(1) ADC 1227 (Reference. 3.) added Air Force-specific data elements to the DLMS 832N Catalog Data Support transaction to allow Air Force CICPs to transmit catalog data to the Air Force accountable property system of record (APSR).

(2) Air Force CICPs will transmit the DLMS 832N when creating or updating a record associated with an Air Force local stock number (LSN). The Air Force refers to this information as item indicative data. After creating an LSN, the CICIP will send a DLMS 832N to the APSR each time it updates item indicative data.

(3) ADC 1227 includes DLMS Notes for each Air Force-requested data element. The DLMS Note explains whether DLMS 832N IC requires the CICIP to use the data element, or if the data element is optional based on specified conditions.

(4) The Air Force reported that the DLMS Notes, as written in ADC 1227, were not descriptive enough. In their current state, the DLMS 832N IC DLMS Notes define most of the Air Force data elements as “must use.” The Air Force APSR only requires DLMS 832N data elements when the CICIP creates a new LSN record. Otherwise, the CICIP will only include these data elements when updating the associated item indicative information for a particular LSN record.

(5) Finally, the Air Force provided desired criteria for the applicable DLMS notes. These criteria define when the Air Force CICPs must include the data element, for example, when the DLMS 832N contains newly established LSN records. Next, the criteria only require the CICIP to use the data elements if the DLMS 832N indicates an update to the item indicative information associated with those data elements.

c. Approved Change in Detail: This approved change revises the applicable DLMS Notes in the DLMS 832N IC. The revised DLMS Notes clarify when the Air Force CICPs will use a data element, for example, when creating a new LSN record or when updating the item indicative information associated with a particular data element. Refer to the Enclosure for changes to the DLMS 832N IC.

d. Revisions to DLM 4000.25 Manuals: Revise the DLMS 832N Catalog Data Support IC as shown in the enclosure.

e. Approved Transaction Flow: This approved change does not modify the transaction flow established in ADC 1227.

f. Alternatives: None.

5. REASON FOR CHANGE: This approved change allows Air Force CICPs to transmit DLMS 832Ns that convey item indicative data only when it is newly created or updated.

6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

a. **Advantages:** This approved change will allow the Air Force CICPs to include only the data elements associated with new or updated item indicative information. Without this change, the CICPs must transmit all data elements defined as “must use,” in the DLMS Note, even if there is no update to that particular piece of information.

b. **Disadvantages:** None identified.

7. ESTIMATED TIME LINE/IMPLEMENTATION TARGET: Air Force CICPs and the Air Force APSR may implement this change upon release of the approved DLMS Change.

8. ESTIMATED SAVINGS/COST AVOIDANCE ASSOCIATED WITH IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS CHANGE: The Air Force did not provide estimated cost savings or cost avoidance information.
