# 4. APPROVED CHANGE(S):

- **a.** <u>Brief Overview of Change</u>: Remove the combatant command (COCOM) field from the Routing Identifier Code (RIC) table.
- **b.** <u>Background</u>: In September of 2008, ADC 298 (Reference 3.b) added a collection of disparate changes to the DoDAAD. One of those changes was to associate the geographic

COCOM to the DoDAAC. The COCOM was associated to the Type Address Code (TAC) 2 (Shipping) of the DoDAAC to assist with tracking of material during transport. Subsequent to that change, the COCOM was also associated to the RIC. The RIC change likely occurred due to the fact the DoDAAC and RIC share the same database table. This, however, was a mistake, and this change serves to remove that mistake.

- **c.** <u>Approved Change in Detail</u>: Remove the COCOM field from the RIC record and all the places where it is currently used (RIC update, DAASINQ, eDAASINQ, file downloads and syndication).
- **d.** Revisions to DLM 4000.25 Manuals: No update to DLMS Volume 6, Chapter 2 is required. The COCOM to RIC relation is not mentioned in DoDAAC manual.
  - e. Alternatives: None
- **5. REASON FOR CHANGE:** The RIC is not used for shipping, as it is not a transportation code. It is thus erroneous to associate a COCOM to a RIC.

#### **6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:**

- a. Advantages: Removes irrelevant data from the RIC.
- **b. <u>Disadvantages</u>**: None noted.
- 7. ESTIMATED TIME LINE/IMPLEMENTATION TARGET: Authorized for immediate implementation when this DLMS change is released as an ADC. Target timeline for DAAS updates to the DoDAAD is 90 days from the publication of the ADC.
- **8. ESTIMATED SAVINGS/COST AVOIDANCE ASSOCIATED WITH IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS CHANGE:** The cost savings is unknown. This change is to correct a known mistake.

### 9. IMPACT:

- a. New DLMS Data Elements: None
- **b.** Changes to DLMS Data Elements: None.
- **c.** <u>Automated Information Systems (AIS)</u>: Any systems using the COCOM data from the RIC will be impacted by this change.
- **d. <u>DAAS</u>**: Set COCOM to null in the RIC field/table and remove the trigger that maintains the COCOM in the RIC. Changes will be required to the following:
- (1) Remove COCOM from RIC in the RIC update, DAASINQ, eDAASINQ and downloads.
- (2) Remove dropdown list from eDAASINQ to select COCOM value for search when searching for a RIC record.

- **e.** <u>FLIS Portfolio Data Warehouse (FPDW) Program Office</u>. Ensure these changes are implemented in all syndication of DoDAAD data from FPDW.
- **f.** <u>Army and Air Force</u>. Army and Air Force must make the necessary changes to their respective DoDAAC applications to mirror these changes to the DoDAAD.
- **g.** <u>Non-DLM 4000.25 Series Publications</u>: The changes identified herein will need to be incorporated into the relevant Service/Agency-level DoDAAD management publications, including (but not limited to) the following:

(1) U.S. Army: AR 725-50

(2) U.S. Air Force: AFI 24-230

(3) U.S. Marine Corps: MCO 4400.201

(4) U.S. Coast Guard: COMDTINST M4000.2

(5) Defense Information Systems Agency: DISA Instruction 270-50-10

(6) Federal Property Management Regulations (CFR 41)
