### 4. APPROVED CHANGE(S):

- **a.** <u>Brief Overview of Change</u>: The DoDAAD update application only supports DoDAAC and RIC updates. DoDAACs are six characters and RICs are three characters. Each is a unique field and should be handle separately. This change adds separate fields and removes the need to enter ZZZ for RICs, which is misleading since the RIC is only used as a three-character field in all applications.
- **b.** <u>Background</u>: One database is used for both DoDAACs and RICs. Internally, they use the same key field. The difference between the two is the RIC begins with ZZZ (followed by the three character RIC) and only stores data in the TAC 1 (owner) and COMMRI elements.

## c. Changes in Detail:

### (1) <u>DoDAAD Advance Search (eDAASINQ) Application:</u>

(a) Remove the ZZZ requirement on the Update DoDAAC entry screen and replace with a radio buttons and separate fields to indicate if update is to a DoDAAC or RIC. The new page will function as follows:

<u>1.</u> If DoDAAC field is selected via the radio button, the RIC field is disabled and only the DoDAAC field is enabled. Six characters are required to designate a DoDAAC. If the user enters "ZZZ" and error message must appears and say, "RICs must be entered using the RIC field.

2. If a RIC field is selected via the radio button, the DoDAAC field is disable and only the RIC field is enabled and three characters are required to designate the RIC. The field must be limited to three characters and all three characters are required.

**(b)** Update the Update DoDAAC application search page and remove the footnote:
