4. APPROVED CHANGE:

a. **Brief Overview of Change:** This change will convert four Federal EDI Implementation Conventions (IC) to DLMS ICs and repost them to the DLMS IC section of the EBSO Website (Reference 3.a).

b. **Background:**

(1) A companion Approved DLMS Change (ADC 1344, Reference 3.b.) will remove numerous outdated and unused Federal ICs from the EBSO Website (Reference 3.a.). The EBSO continues to maintain four Federal ICs to support requirements for the Procurement Integrated Enterprise Environment (PIEE), Wide Area Workflow (WAWF) module and the Defense Automatic Addressing System (DAAS). These are:

- (a) Federal 856 Advance Shipment Notice (ASN),
- (b) Federal 857 Shipment and Billing Notice (No existing DLMS IC), and
- (c) Federal 861 Acceptance Report.
- (d) The Federal 997 Functional Acknowledgement IC is used by DAAS.

(2) DoDD 8190.01E, Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS) (Reference 3.c.) was reissued “*to establish the DLMS as the DoD standard for transactional information exchanges among the automated information systems (AISs) that comprise assigned business processes of the DoD logistics and global supply chain management system.*”

DoDD 1890.01E also directs the use of DLMS transactions in business functions:

“5. *The DoD Component heads:*

- a. *Support the DLMS change management process in accordance with References (f) and (g).*
- b. *Uniformly implement the DLMS in all AISs that perform business functions that support the global supply chain management system and are covered in References (g), (i), and (j).*
- c. *Use the services of the DLMS global services providers to support the AISs that perform the business functions covered by References (g), (i), and (j).*
- d. *Use DLMS for ASC X12 transactions with contractors in accordance with the Federal Acquisition Regulation, subpart 53.105 (Reference (m)).*”

(3) Throughout the 1990s and into the 2000s, the EBSO developed DoD ICs as supplements to overarching Federal ICs and contributed to developing the Federal ICs. In the 2000s, the EDI Standards Management Committee (EDISMC) coordination effort moved under the Business Transformation Agency (BTA). The funding for the various standards management

committees was eliminated and at some point in the early to mid-2000s, the coordination effort of the Federal EDI Standards Management Coordinating Committee (FESMCC), DoD EDISMC, ceased to operate. In September 2008, FIPS 161-2 was cancelled and in 2015, an updated DoDD 8190.01E was issued to reflect the current status.

(4) The EBSO continued to push new and revised versions of the DLMS ICs to the BTA for posting on their FedeBiz Website until the BTA was reorganized and the FedeBiz Website was no longer maintained in the late 2000s.

c. Approved Administrative Change in Detail:

(1) Revise the existing Federal IC designations to convert the Federal ICs used by PIEE/WAWF and DAAS (997) to DLMS ICs. The table below shows the existing and revised IC designations. Where there was an existing Federal and DLMS versions, the Federal version will retain the existing number with no alpha character and the DLMS versions will have “P” appended. See the table below. Enclosure 1 identifies the updates required to the wording in the IC transaction level notes.

(2) In the existing DLMS ICs, (856 ASN and 861), the remaining Federal Notes will remain pending further process analysis and collaboration between EBSO and the PIEE/WAWF team. The future goal being to validate the existing data requirement and possibly combine the existing requirement for dual 856 ASN and 861 Acceptance transactions into single DLMS 856 ASN and 861 ICs.

(3) There are no changes to the existing procedures defined in these four ICs.

d. Revisions to DLM 4000.25 Manuals: None. Several administrative changes are identified in ADC 1344 (Reference 3.b.).
