**4. APPROVED CHANGE(S):**

a. **Brief Overview of Change:** This administrative change updates multiple DLMS implementation conventions ((IC) to change the usage attribute of the N106 to “Used” rather than “Must Use”. This allows for multiple occurrences of the relevant N1 Name Loops when multiple types of addresses are used.

b. **Background:** Numerous DLMS ICs have the N106 Entity Identifier Code marked as “Must Use”. This was to ensure the transaction included the FR – Message From to indicate the organization cited in the N104 Identification Code Data Element is the originator of the transaction. Over time, requirements evolved and EBSO included additional organization types to the N1 segment requiring more than one occurrence of the respective N1 Name loop. The “Must Use” indicator presents validation issues under the extensible markup language (XML) and causes the transactions to fail if the N106 data element is not included. This is not the case

for X12 and electronic data interchange (EDI) users. EBSO corrected several DLMS transactions previously identified during DPAS implementation and testing. This administrative change will update several DLMS transactions where the attributes of the N106 data element is “Must Use” to “Used” to avoid any errors that may occur in the future.

**c. Approved Change in Detail:** This administrative change updates the relevant N106 data element usage designation in the following DLMS IC: 511M, 511R, 527D, 527R, 567C, 856N, 4030 856N, 861, 861P, 867D, 867I, 870L, 870M, 870N, 870S, 945A, 4030 945A, and 947I as shown in Enclosure 1. This change will not affect existing implementation of the DLMS transactions that are included in this change.

**d. Revisions to DLM 4000.25 Manuals:** None

**e. Approved Transaction Flow:** No Change

**f. Alternatives:** None – The change is required to prevent transactions failing at DAAS.
