- **3. REFERENCE:** DLM 4000.25, Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS), Volume 6, Chapter 2, Department of Defense Activity Address Directory.
- 4. APPROVED CHANGE(S):
- **a. Brief Overview of Change:** Remove the Bill of Lading Office Code (BLOC) from the DoDAAD.

b. Background:

- (1) The DoDAAD currently carries the BLOC, but it is defined in the Defense Transportation Regulation (DTR) (DoD 4500.9-R) and maintained in the TRANSCOM Reference Data Management (TRDM) database.
- (2) Originally, the BLOC was manually set by the Central Service Point (CSP), but due to questionable data quality, the logic was changed in 2009 to directly load the BLOC from TRDM. During the past eleven years, the data feed from TRDM broke down, but no one noticed.
- (3) Of the 923 BLOCs, 382are missing and 2 BLOCs from the DoDAAD were invalid. Per Defense Transportation Regulation, Part II, appendix H, the Bill of Lading Office Code (BLOC) Listing, United States Transportation Command (USTRANSCOM) Reference Data Management (TRDM) is the authoritative data source of BLOC.

c. Approved Change in Detail:

(1) DAAS. Remove the BLOC data element from the DoDAAD database

(2) DAAS. Remove the display of the BLOC element from DoDAAD update, DAASINQ, eDAASINQ, download files, Web Service and Oracle Replication.
