# Approved Defense Logistics Management Standards Change 1408 Requisitions With Priority Designator 09-15 and Special Requirements Code 777

### 1. ORIGINATING SERVICE/AGENCY AND POC INFORMATION:

- **a.** <u>Technical POC</u>: Mr. Marc Davis, NAVSUP WSS T&D (N31), (757)492-5291, 646-5291.

#### 2. REASON FOR CHANGE:

- **a.** <u>Bottom Line Up-Front</u>: Remove requirement to blank Special Requirements Code 777 for requisitions submitted with Priority Designators (PD) 09-15.
- **b.** <u>Background</u>: The Navy requested this change after finding a discrepancy with the Special Requirement Code 777 between the Defense Transportation Regulation (DTR) and Defense Logistics Manual (DLM). The DLM's requirement causes shipments to move by non-expedited means due to its lower priority categorization. This change will allow for expedited shipment for CONUS-OCONUS shipments as permitted by the DTR.

### 3. CHANGE IN DETAIL:

- **a.** <u>Technical Details</u>: DLM 4000.25, Volume 2, Appendix 7.14, Paragraph AP7.14.11.2, change PD 01-08 to 01-15. DLM 4000.25, Volume 2, Chapter 4, in Table C4.T4 Priority Designator change to read "If Expedited Transportation Signal 777 is present and PD 01-15 is present, process. If Expedited Transportation Signal 777 is present and PD 01-15 is blank, enter PD 08 and furnish BK supply status."
- **b.** Revised Transaction Flow: There are no changes to the existing procedures or process flows as a result of this change.
- **4. IMPLEMENTATION TARGET:** Changes should be implemented 30 days after this ADC is published.

#### **5. TECHNICAL IMPACT:**

- **a.** Additions or Changes to Data Elements: Special requirements code/required delivery date will remain 777.
- **b.** <u>Automated Information Systems (AIS)</u>: This change affects primarily the DAAS transaction mapping for requisitions. At the time of this change, there are no known impacts to requisitioning systems.

**c.** <u>Defense Automatic Addressing System (DAAS)</u>: Update the DAAS mapping logic in accordance with this change. The Special Requirements Code 777 will no longer be removed from the requisitions.

Priority Designator <sup>1</sup>	1. If Expedited Handling Signal 999 is present in the Special Requirements Code field, requisition is for U.S. Forces and the PD is not 01-03, enter PD 03 and furnish BK supply status.
	2. If an OSD/JCS project code is present and the PD entry is not an existing PD code (not 01-15), enter PD 03 and furnish BK supply status.
	3. If NMCS/ANMCS indicator (N/E) is present in the Special Requirements Code field and the PD entry is not an existing PD code (not 01-15), enter PD 08 and furnish BK supply status.
	4. If special mass cancellation coding 555 is present and the PD entry is not an existing PD code (not 01-15), enter PD 08 and furnish BK supply status.
	5. If Expedited Transportation Signal 777 is present and the PD entry is not an existing PD code (not 01-15), enter PD 08 and furnish BK supply status. If Expedited Transportation Signal 777 is present and PD 01-15 is present, process. If Expedited Transportation Signal 777 is present and PD 01-15 is blank, enter PD 08 and furnish BK supply status.

6. If required availability date (A in first position of Special Requirements Code field) is present and the PD entry is not an existing PD code (not 01-15), enter PD 15.
7. If extended RDD (S or X) is present and PD is other than 09-15, enter PD 15, furnish BK supply status, and process.
8. If work stoppage indicator (F or R) is present and PD is not 01-08, enter PD 8, furnish BK supply status, and process.
9. For all other conditions, if PD is not 01-15, enter PD 15.

In DLM 4000.25, Volume 2, Chapter 4, in Table C4.T4 Priority Designator, change 5 to read PD Code (not 09-15).
