Approved Defense Logistics Management Standards Change 1439 Defense Logistics Management Standards 842 Discrepancy Reporting Implementation Convention Updates

2. REASON FOR CHANGE:

a. Bottom Line Up-Front: Substantive updates made after approved proposed change are identified in green highlighting.

(1) This change updates the following Defense Logistics Management Standard (DLMS) Implementation Conventions (ICs) based upon current Defense Logistics Agency Warehouse Management System (WMS) requirements.

(a) 842A/W Standard Supply Discrepancy Report (SDR), Follow-up, Correction, Cancellation, and Reconsideration Request.

(b) 842A/R Standard Supply Discrepancy Report (SDR) Reply.

(c) 842C/I Stock Screening Request.

(d) 842C/R Stock Screening Reply.

(2) This change also updates the DLMS 842A/W IC Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) code field to be completed with “UNKNW” when missing during the receipt process for Wrong Item SDRs.

b. Background: During the WMS implementation for the Corpus Christi Distribution Center these DLMS 842 IC updates/improvements were identified:

(1) Provide clarification on data elements; and

(2) Remove unused data qualifiers.

3. CHANGE IN DETAIL:

a. Technical Details: Update the four DLMS 842 series ICs as shown in the enclosure.

b. Revised Transaction Flow: Standard SDR process flow applies.

4. IMPLEMENTATION TARGET: DoD Components must plan for a target implementation date not to exceed 2 years.

5. TECHNICAL IMPACT:

a. **Additions or Changes to Data Elements**: See enclosure.

b. **Automated Information Systems (AIS)**: At a minimum the following SDR systems must make updates: Product Deficiency Reporting and Evaluation Program (PDREP), General Service Administration Vision, DLA Distribution Standard System (DSS), Enterprise Business System (EBS), and WMS, Army Logistics Modernization Program (LMP), Air Force Security Assistance and Cooperation, Air Force Wholesale D035K, and Air Force Integrated Logistics System-Supply (ILSS).

c. **Defense Automatic Addressing System (DAAS)**: DAAS will need to update the WebSDR application to ensure the translator aligns with the changes documented in this proposal.
