1. ORIGINATING SERVICE/AGENCY AND POC INFORMATION

2. REASON FOR CHANGE:

a. **Bottom Line Up-Front:** This change incorporates new qualifiers and notes into the Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS) 940R, Materiel Release Implementation Convention (IC). It will facilitate the United States Air Force (USAF) Stock Control System's (SCS) transition from the legacy Military Standard Transaction Reporting and Accountability Procedures (MILSTRAP), document identifier code A5E, for handling materiel release order (MRO) processing. ***This change impacts Air Force and DLA only. Components should review for potential applicability and discuss with DEDSO prior to use.***

b. This MFR Administrative ADC adds missing language to codes P2 and P3 in position 2/W506/0200 in the 940R DLMS IC in Enclosure 1. ADC 1470A replaces ADC 1470 in its entirety.

c. **Background:** A direct, non-compliant, connect interface exists between the USAF SCS and the DLA's Distribution Standard System (DSS). The interface with DSS allows for the USAF to maintain mission-essential operations by utilizing post-post issues during unexpected circumstances related to outages of the DLA's Enterprise Business System (EBS) and materiel being released from Point of Use locations near maintenance lines. However, DLA Distribution is modernizing its warehousing system from DSS to the Warehouse Management System (WMS). This modernization eliminates the direct connect interface which exists between the USAF SCS and DSS for processing post-post issues making it necessary to establish new qualifiers to allow the USAF to identify when a pick ticket is required. As the USAF captured requirements for the transition to the DLMS 940R transaction, it was determined that using the aircraft tail number would assist maintenance with determining where materiel should be delivered and identified the need to provide the Foreign Military Sales (FMS) exchange unit price for financial reporting purposes.

3. CHANGE IN DETAIL:

a. **Technical Details:**

(1) Add new qualifier TAL - Aircraft Tail Number to the DLMS 940R transaction (2/N901/0400) as shown in Enclosure 1. The tail number is a 12 alphanumeric position field which identifies the aircraft tail number the item will be placed.

(2) Add new DLMS note to existing qualifier EL - Present Market Value to allow for the communication of the FMS exchange unit price in the DLMS 940R transaction as shown in Enclosure 1.

(3) Add two new Transaction Type codes to the DLMS 940R transaction to specify it as a post-post issue. New qualifier P2 - Employer Group Change will indicate a post-post issue which requires a pick ticket and new qualifier P3 - Individual Change will indicate a post-post issue which requires no pick ticket as shown in Enclosure 1.

b. Revised Transaction Flow:

(1) In this scenario, the DLMS 940R transaction is the first communication between the USAF and the Storage Activity. Therefore, the USAF must provide the Standard Line of Accounting data as part of the DLMS 940R transaction. Refer to DLM 4000.25, Volume 4 and Approved DLMS Change (ADC) 1043.

(2) USAF will transmit the DLMS 940R transaction to DLA Distribution via DAAS. The transaction will include the appropriate USAF data elements necessary to support the materiel release capability required to maintain mission essential operations during unexpected circumstances to include the new DLMS 940R data elements identified in paragraph 3a.

(3) All other components must coordinate implementation with DEDSO prior to use.

4. IMPLEMENTATION TARGET: Implementation is expected to occur when the DLA Warehouse Management System goes live at DLA Distribution Hill in September 2025.

5. TECHNICAL IMPACT:

a. Additions or Changes to Data Element:

(1) Add new qualifier TAL - Aircraft Tail Number to the DLMS 940R transaction (2/N901/0400) and mapping. DEDSO will submit a data maintenance action to ASC X12 to establish TAL in a future version.

(2) Add new DLMS note to existing qualifier EL - Present Market Value to allow communication of the FMS exchange unit price in the DLMS 940R transaction (2/AMT01/0800).

(3) Add new qualifier P2 – Employer Group Change to the DLMS 940R Materiel Release transaction (1/W0506/0200) and mapping.

(4) Add DLMS note to new qualifier P2 – Employer Group Change to specify the qualifier is used to convey a post-post transaction requires a pick ticket.

(5) Add new qualifier P3 - Individual Change to the DLMS 940R Materiel Release transaction (1/W0506/0200) and mapping.

(6) Add DLMS note to new qualifier P3 - Individual Change to specify the qualifier is used to convey a post-post transaction that does not require a pick ticket.

(7) Update DLMS note for qualifier W1- Reconcile Historical Records in segment 1/W0507/0200 to include new qualifiers P2 and P3 from segment 1/W0506/0200.

b. Defense Automatic Addressing System (DAAS): Update the DLMS 940R transaction mapping in accordance with this change. DAAS must ensure the new data elements under the DLMS 940R transaction are available for use by the implementation date.

c. Automated Information System (AIS): The following AISs, at a minimum, must be updated to reflect the procedures as described above upon approval:

(1) USAF SCS

(2) DLA WMS
