Memorandum For Record Approved Defense Logistics Management Standards Change 1473, Administrative update to transactions 842A/W, 842A/R, and Defense Logistics Manual 4000.25, Volume 2, Appendix 7.28, Supply Discrepancy Report (SDR) Relevant Data Elements

1. ORIGINATING SERVICE/AGENCY AND POC INFORMATION: Defense Enterprise Data Standards Office (DEDSO), Ben Breen, <u>DEDSO.SDR@dla.mil</u>.

2. REASON FOR CHANGE:

a. Bottom Line Up-Front: This change:

1) Updates the 842A/W, Standard Supply Discrepancy Report (SDR), Follow-up, Correction, Cancellation, & Reconsideration Request Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS) Implementation Convention (IC) notes to remove the "must use" requirement from position 1700 of the PER segment_and adds clarity to specific qualifiers shown in Enclosure 1.

2) Updates the DLMS notes in DLMS 842A/W and 842A/R, QTY segments 2/QTY03/2700 and 2/QTY03-01/2700 to provide clarification on the usage of the X12 unit of measure.

3) Updates Defense Logistics Manual (DLM) 4000.25, Volume 2, Appendix 7.28, SDR Relevant Data Elements by reassigning former 500-series reply codes to the interim reply series codes shown in Enclosure 2.

4) Reassigns Reply Codes 320 and 321 from the 300-series and Reply Code 608 from the 600-series to the interim reply series codes as shown in Enclosure 2.

b. <u>Background</u>: The Defense Automatic Addressing System (DAAS) WebSDR Tech Team is preparing to transmit SDR data to Advana. During these discussions it was noted that some SDR reply codes need to be moved to the correct series to ensure WebSDR can code these reply codes with the correct metadata when transmitting data to Advana. Aligning these codes to the correct series will allow WebSDR to align metadata correctly. Also, updating the DLMS IC notes to provide clarity on specific qualifiers will allow new SDR systems to program the correct length and characters allowed for specific qualifiers.
