Intra-DLA Revisions to the DLMS 940R, Release Order, and Associated Procedures to Support Directed Release of Materiel under RBI

1. ORIGINATING SERVICE/AGENCY AND POC INFORMATION:

3. BACKGROUND:

a. General.

- (1) The DLA Disposition Services (formerly Defense Reutilization and Marketing Service (DRMS)) is a worldwide presence within the Department of Defense, with disposal specialists in 14 foreign countries, two U.S territories, and 39 states. DLA Disposition Services mission is the execution of disposition solutions for excess military property. The Reutilization Business Integration (RBI) project will replace the DRMS Automated Information System (commonly referred to as DAISY) by integrating DLA Disposition Services business processes within the DLA enterprise suite of applications, including the Enterprise Business system (EBS).
- (2) Additional data content will be required in the DLMS 940R, Materiel Release, under the enhanced business process. DLA EBS will send the DLMS 940R to the storage activity operating under the Distribution Standard System (DSS).
- **b.** Scenario for which the transaction is used: There are three scenarios in which the DLMS 940R will be used that require the additional data specified in this change.
- (1) The DLMS 940R will be used to communicate the release of property from a DLA Disposition Services Field Office. A Materiel Release Order (MRO), Document Identifier Code (DIC) A5_(A,E,1,5), transaction will be sent for a sale/free issue. Based on the information on the order received by DSS, the customer will either be allowed to pick up or be shipped their property from the DLA Disposition Services Field Office, or the property will be moved to another DLA Disposition Services Field Office. A Disposal Release Order (DRO), DIC A5J, will be sent for a disposal action. A Redistribution Order, DIC A2A or A2E, will be sent for a redistribution action.
- (2) The DLMS 940R will also be used to cancel a release, DICs AC6 or ACJ, or to follow-up on a cancellation request for which there has been no response, DICs AK6 or AKJ. The 940R will include a flag to indicate whether the cancellation is mandatory or optional. The cancellation request may be triggered either by the customer's request or systematically. The cancellation may be

systematically triggered if payment is not received or property characteristics change that affect the customer's eligibility to receive the property.

- (3) The DLMS 940R will also be used to communicate a follow-up request for the status of an action. A DIC AF6 or AFJ will be sent on a daily basis for all open release orders in Supply Status BA indicating the item is open and is being processed for release and shipment. The standard EBS timing for this type of follow-up runs every day from 2100 to 0300 the following day.
- c. Procedures, transactions, data elements, processing details in use today: In the current DLA Disposition Services system, there is no need to have a transaction to communicate the release, cancellation, cancellation follow-up, or status follow-up on a materiel release, since this is all handled within one system: DAISY. Transaction Type Codes (TTC) are used in DAISY to execute different actions, and with each TTC, specific data regarding the action to be taken is entered. Since today's process uses one system to manage both the orders and inventory, there is no action required to communicate the release of materiel. The order is simply created in DAISY, and after the property is removed, a materiel release confirmation is entered into DAISY to adjust the inventory. When there is a cancellation, the order is deleted within DAISY; no cancellation follow-up is required. The concept of communicating the release of materiel and of requesting a cancellation will be new for RBI.

4. **PROPOSED CHANGE(S):**

- **a.** Requested change in detail: This change enhances the business process using the DLMS Materiel Release transaction to accommodate the additional information that will need to be sent to DSS from EBS under the RBI re-engineering.
- Containerization is the process where by DLA Disposition Services personnel determine, based on prior experiences, that specific NSNs will sell better if they are merchandised as a set. When this is determined, the DLA Disposition Services personnel will group together the items that they want to try to sell as a set by putting them in a container. Each container will have a number which is called a Disposition Services Container Identification. However, items in a container do not necessarily have to be sold on a single order; customers may choose to requisition some items in a container without requisitioning all of them. The Disposition Services Container ID will be included on the release order. In order to communicate to DSS whether a partial or full container was requisitioned, a Disposition Services Indicator for Container Issued in Full will be sent on the DLMS 940R. The Container Issued in Full will be marked if each Disposal Turn-In Document (DTID) in the container is on an order communicated to DSS on the DLMS 940R.
 - (2) Additional new data content is described below.
 - (3) Refer to Enclosure 1 for DLMS Supplement revisions.

b. Proposed procedures:

(1) This change updates the DLMS 940R Materiel Release transaction sent between DLA Disposition Services ICP (using EBS) and the DLA Disposition Services Field Offices (using DSS). EBS will send DSS a DLMS 940R when property is ready to be released to a customer. It will also be sent to communicate a cancellation, and to communicate a follow-up request for the status of an action. This will all be done at the DTID level of detail.

- (2) **Disposal Turn-In Document (DTID) Number.** The DTID Number will be passed to DSS on every MRO sent to DSS for a usable property. This will allow materiel to be released at this more detailed level of inventory. *Staffing Note:* DLA Disposition Services confirms that materiel release transactions associated with RBI will not include a document number suffix (i.e., for release of property to fill a requisition from multiple DLA Disposition Services Field Offices or from multiple DTIDs under the customer's requisition document number in order to satisfy quantity requested). Instead, separate unique document numbers will be created.¹
- (3) Release of Disposition Services Property in a Container. The customer has the option to requisition either the entire container or certain items from a container (each identified by the DTID Number) established by the DLA Disposition Services Field Office during receipt processing.² A separate requisition is sent to EBS for each item in the container regardless of whether the whole container is selected for requisition by the customer. This allows a unique document number to be generated for each item and provides visibility of the item to the customer. In the requisitions sent to EBS, there will be an indicator on the DLMS 511R transaction that will notify EBS if the whole container was requisitioned, at which time EBS can then verify that all requisitions for that container are received and processed. A similar indicator will also be on the DS 940R sent from EBS to DSS. At the time of issue, DSS can perform a similar check to validate all transactions are received for the full container, if the full container indicator is checked on the DLMS 940R. The DTID Number and the container ID will be on each DLMS 940R.

(4) Demilitarization Code and Demilitarization Integrity Code.

- (a) DSS receives updates on the DEMIL and DEMIL Integrity Codes more frequently than EBS. Since EBS DEMIL data may not be as up to date as DSS, EBS needs to pass this to DSS so that it can validate that a property is still eligible for requisition by a particular customer prior to the physical release of property.
- **(b)** If the DEMIL code sent on the 940R from EBS does not match what DSS has on record, DSS will hold the property for a period of time to allow EBS to catch up and send an MRO cancellation if necessary. If, at the end of the waiting period, EBS has not sent DSS an MRO cancellation, DSS will resume processing the MRO. Additionally, if the DEMIL Code is Q, DSS will also need to validate the DEMIL Integrity Codes.

(5) Local Stock Numbers (LSN) and Unit of Use under RBI.

- (a) Materiel Release transactions may use the LSN assigned for materiel identification. This is applicable when property turned in to DLA Disposition Services cannot be identified to a National Stock Number (NSN).
- (b) Additionally, if an item is turned in to the DLA Disposition Services Field Office, and the receiver identifies a NSN for the item, but the item is less than the FLIS Unit of Issue, the receiver will create a new LSN by replacing the first character of the NIIN with an "R". This form of LSN for Unit of Use will not be visible to the customer as it is provided only for intra-DLA use. The property will be identified to its NSN for DLA Disposition Services' Reutilization/Transfer/Donation (RTD) Web application. For intra-DLA use of the DLMS 940R, it will carry the unit of use

LSN and the cross-reference NSN. The Unit of Use Indicator will define the quantity and unit of measure as applicable to unit of use. The Unit of Use Indicator may be carried on the transaction internally and externally with DLMS trading partners.

- (6) Funds Appropriation Number. The Funds Appropriation Number (Fund Cite/Line of Accounting) will be passed on the MRO and will be used to identify specific orders for RTD customers. This Funds Appropriation Number will be used when it is necessary to calculate transportation costs that may be associated with certain orders that are shipped to RTD customers. The fund cite will be required for Foreigh Military Sales (FMS) orders, so that when DSS receives the MRO, the Transportation Management Office (TMO) will know to which Line of Accounting to charge the shipping costs. Otherwise, TMO will not know to whom to charge shipping costs.

 Staffing Note: Request USTRANSCOM review this procedure for compliance with Standard Financial Information Structure (SFIS) guidance. Components are advised that the DOD is in the process of implementing SFIS for all systems carrying/processing financial information (e.g., lines of accounting, fund codes). The data element for the Funds Appropriation Number was removed under ADC 435 which provides DLMS procedures for SFIS and has be re-instated under this ADC. While use of DLMS Qualifier 18 will be authorized at this time to support RBI legacy processes noted here during transition to SFIS, Components and Agencies will be required to migrate to SFIS procedures. Additional process changes will be addressed in future change proposals.
- (7) Sales Order Reference Number. Disposition Services will include the EBS sales order number when a MRO is sent to DSS for a sales order line item. The internal header level EBS sales order number will be passed in each transaction as secondary to the DTID Number. By passing this number, DSS will be able to tie individual MROs together into one pick order. This data element is also referred to as Reference Document Number within RBI documentation.
 - **c. Alternatives:** None identified.
- **5. REASON FOR CHANGE:** As a result of RBI, DLA Disposition Services will use EBS to manage inventory and property issues. These changes will ensure the same or better functionality exists after the implementation of RBI as before.

6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

- **a.** Advantages (tangible/intangible) EBS and DSS will be able to comply with DLMS standards for the RBI process.
 - b. Disadvantages: None.
- **7. NOTE ANY REGULATIONS OR GUIDANCE:** DOD 4160.21-M, Defense Materiel Disposition Manual; DRMS-I 4160.14 requires update.
- **8. ADDITIONAL FUNCTIONAL REQUIREMENTS:** These changes are being made in the context of the RBI. Separate PDCs are being provided to document additional requirements.
- 9. ESTIMATED TIME LINE/IMPLEMENTATION TARGET: January 2012.
- 10. ESTIMATED SAVINGS/COST AVOIDANCE ASSOCIATED WITH IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS CHANGE: Not Available


b. Automated Information Systems (AIS):

These data elements may be new to this transaction or previously identified on a separate RBI change proposal. There are no known changes to existing DLMS data elements in this ADC. Refer to Enclosure 2 for the actual DLMS mapping for the DLA Disposition Services data requirements.

- The Services will send their DLMS 511R/A0_/AE_ requisitions for DLA Disposition Services through DLA Transaction Services. These transactions will be identified with Source of Supply RIC-To of S9D. DLA Transaction Services will route these transactions to RTD Web for processing.
- 2. The RTD Web will process Services requisitions as well as generating requisitions from the RTD Web. These transactions will be passed through DLA Transaction Services to EBS.
- 3. GSA will batch daily file of A0/AE requisitions and send these to DLA Transaction Services to convert these to DLMS 511R transactions to be sent to EBS.
- 4. EBS will receive the DLMS 511R transactions from GSA and the RTD Web, process these and then trigger a Materiel Release Order (MRO) via a DLMS 940R transaction to DSS.
- 5. DSS provides a DLMS 945A Materiel Release Confirmation that the item was issued.

Enclosure 3, DLMS Manual Revisions

Revise DOD 4000.25-M, Volume 2, Chapter 16, as follows³:

C16.1.4. Processing Requisitions by DRMS DLA Disposition Services.

C16.1.4.1. Materiel Release. The 940R, Materiel Release Order (MRO) (Transaction Type Code 'NA') will be used to direct the release of property from a DLA Disposition Services Field Office. The MRO will be sent from DLA Disposition Services to the Field Office when materiel is being issued as a result of sales, reutilization, transfer or donation. The materiel release process will be accomplished at the DTID level of detail. Rules in DLMS Vol. 2, Chapter 4 apply to the MRO process; however, the transaction may contain the following data to support disposal processing as described below: DTID Number, Disposition Container ID, Container Issued in Full Indicator, Minimum/Maximum Ship Quantity, Sales Order Reference Number, Complete Container Count, Transportation Mode or Method, Cancellation Mandatory/Optional Flag, Customer Type, DEMIL Code, DEMIL Integrity Code, and/or Funds Appropriation Number.

C16.1.4.1.1. Disposal Turn in Document (DTID) Number. The DTID Number will be passed to DLA Disposition Services Field Offices on every MRO sent to DLA Disposition Services Field Offices for a usable property. This will allow material to be released at a more detailed level of inventory.

C16.1.4.1.2. Customer Pick Up. Information contained in the MRO will indicate whether the materiel will be picked up by the customer or shipped. DoD Transportation Mode Code of 'X' will be used to indicate customer pick up; otherwise, the data element will be left blank.

C16.1.4.1.3. Minimum/Maximum Ship Quantity. These quantities will identify allowable over and under release quantities.

C16.1.4.1.4. Disposition Services Customer Type. This data element is used by the DLA Disposition Services Field Office to prioritize the workload stating of MROs. The codes used are: R (Reutilization) - Agencies within the DoD and programs that are provided for by regulation; T (Transfer) - Customers who are Federal Agencies which may receive property from other Federal Agencies; D (Donation) - Customers who are non-profit organizations who work with the State Agencies for Surplus Property (SASPs) to withdraw DoD property; and S (Sales).

C16.1.4.1.5. Property in a Container. MROs generated by the DLA Disposition Services for requisitioned items associated with a container will have the Disposition Services Container ID identified on the MRO. In addition to the Disposition Services Container ID, MROs generated based on the customer ordering the entire container will contain a Disposition Services Indicator for Container Issued in Full and the count of the total number of DTIDs within the container. will allow DLA Disposition Service Field Offices to insure that an MRO for each item/DTID associated with a container is received and processed. Upon shipment of the materiel for each MRO, the DLA Disposition Service Field Offices will send the 856S Shipment Status (Transaction Type 'AS') to the customer containing DTID, customer or RTD Web-generated requisition document number, and associated Disposition Container ID.

C16.1.4.1.6. Demilitarization Code and Demilitarization Integrity Code. DLA Disposition Services passes these data elements to the DLA Disposition Services Field Offices in order to validate that a property is still eligible for requisition by a particular customer prior to the physical release of property. Based upon frequency and timing of updates, the DEMIL and DEMIL Integrity Codes resident in DLA Disposition Services Field Office records may be more current than the data passed in the MRO by DLA Disposition Services. Therefore, if the DEMIL code sent on the 940R, MRO, does not match the DLA Disposition Services Field Office record, the Field Office will hold the property for a period of time to allow DLA Disposition Services records to be updated, and send an MRO cancellation if necessary. Additionally, if the DEMIL Code is Q, the Field Office will also need to validate the DEMIL Integrity Codes prior to release. If at the end of an established waiting period DLA Disposition Services has not sent the MRO cancellation, the Field Office will resume processing.

C16.1.4.1.7. Local Stock Number (LSN)/Unit of Use. The 940R will carry the unit of use LSN and the cross-reference NSN. The Unit of Use Indicator will define the quantity and unit of measure as applicable to unit of use. See paragraph 16.6.1. below for assignment and use of LSNs, including Unit of Use LSNs.

C16.1.4.1.8. Funds Appropriation Number. This number will be used on the 940R, MRO, when there are transportation costs that may be associated with certain orders that are shipped to RTD customers. For FMS orders, it is required by the Transportation Management Office (TMO) in order to correctly charge shipping costs.

C16.1.4.1.9. Sales Order Reference Number. DLA Disposition Services will include the sales order number on the 940R, MRO sent to DLA Disposition Services Field Offices to direct release of a sales order line item. The sales order reference number will be passed in each transaction as secondary to the DTID Number. This will enable the Field Office to identify all associated MROs into a single pick order.

C16.1.4.2. <u>Materiel Release Order Denial</u>. The DLA Disposition Service Field Office will send DLA Disposition Services the 945A, Materiel Release Order Denial (Transaction Type Code NK), with the appropriate management code, to communicate a denial for materiel when materiel no longer exists or when materiel has been damaged prior to customer pickup. This will include the use of denial management code "Q" for instances where there is enough on-hand materiel to fill the order, but not enough materiel on the disposal turn in document (DTID) number specified on the MRO.

C16.1.4.3. <u>Materiel Release Order Confirmation</u>. When confirming MROs, the DLA Disposition Services Field Office will provide the 945A, Materiel Release Order Confirmation (Transaction Type Code NJ) to the DLA Disposition Services following the prescribed rules in DLMS Volume 2, Chapter 4. However, in addition, this transaction will always contain the disposal turn-in document (DTID) number or a unique value assigned by DLA Disposition Services during receipt and carried as a DTID number allowing release at a more detailed level of inventory.

C16.1.4.4. Follow-up for Materiel Release Order Status. The 940R, MRO Follow-Up (Transaction Type Code 'NB') will be used to communicate the follow-up request for status on open MROs. The DLA Disposition Services Field Office shall provide MRO status using the 945A, Materiel Release Order Status (Transaction Type Code NL), as prescribed in DLMS Volume 2, Chapter 4.

C16.1.4.5. Requisition and Materiel Release Cancellation.

C16.1.4.5.1. Customer Requisition Cancellations Based Upon Submission of 869C, Customer Cancellation Request (Transaction Type Code 'ND'). (Procedures to be documented separately.)

C16.1.4.5.2. MRO Cancellations Requiring an MRO Cancellation Request Transaction. The 940R, MRO Cancellation Request (Transaction Type Code "ND") will be used to request cancellation of a MRO, and to follow-up on cancellation requests for which there has been no response. The MRO cancellation request can be triggered either by the customer's submission of an 869C, Cancellation (Transaction Type Code 'AC') as described above, or systemically by DLA Disposition Services if required payment is not received or when an item property characteristics change affects the customer's eligibility to receive the property, e.g., DEMIL code change. The MRO cancellation request will contain the DTID of the materiel to be cancelled and may contain a Disposition Services Indicator for Cancellation Action Mandatory. Normally systemic cancellations requested by DLA Disposition Services will carry the mandatory cancellation indicator. The Field Office will reply to the 940R MRO Cancellation Request with a 945A, Materiel Release Cancellation Advice (Transaction Type Code 'NR') or Materiel Release Status (Transaction Type Code 'NL'). Upon receipt of the 945A, the DLA Disposition Services will adjust inventory as appropriate. For unit of use LSNs, the 945A will carry the unit of use LSN and the cross-reference NSN. The Unit of Use Indicator will define the quantity and unit of measure as applicable to unit of use. See paragraph 16.6.1. below for assignment and use of LSNs, including Unit of Use LSNs.

C16.1.4.5.3. Customer Requisition Cancellation without Submission of 869C, Customer Cancellation Request (Transaction Type Code 'AC') or the Subsequent 940R, Materiel Release Order Cancellation Request (Transaction Type Code 'ND'). DLA Disposition Services allows cancellation of submitted requisitions based upon customer declining the ordered materiel available for pick up at the Disposition Services Field Office. In these instances, the DLA Disposition Field Office shall notify DLA Disposition Services of the cancellation by providing the 945A, Materiel Release Order Cancellation Confirmation (Transaction Type Code NR), which will contain DLMS Cancellation Reason Code D, E, F, G, H, or I, as appropriate. Subsequently, DLA Disposition Services shall communicate requisition status to their RTD Web in order to make the cancellation visible to the customer.

C16.1.4.5.4. DLA Disposition Services shall not process mass cancellation requests.
