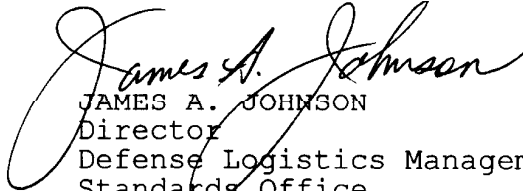
SUBJECT: Approved MILSTRAP Change Letter (AMCL) 15, New  
Ownership Code 0 (Zero) to Identify DoD  
Special Operations Forces (SOF) Ownership  
(Staffed by PMCL 12)

The attached is published as an approved change to DoD 4000.25-M, Defense Logistics Management System (DLMS) and DoD 4000.25-2-M, Military Standard Transaction Reporting and Accounting Procedures (MILSTRAP), for implementation December 1, 2004 based on responses to the request for implementation date. This change requires coordinated joint implementation. The implementation date selected was the outside date provided by a Component (Army) as discussed at DoD Supply Process Review Committee (PRC) Meeting 00-2.

This change was originally approved December 5, 1995, however, the Components were unable to implement as resources had been shifted to support the Corporate Information Management (CIM) single standard system effort. With the demise of the CIM effort, the Defense Logistics Management Standards Office (DLMSO), in conjunction with the Supply PRC, agreed to establish revised implementation dates for all approved MILS changes which were not implemented during the CIM effort.

During staffing of the proposed change, Army raised concerns over the use of numeric Ownership Code 0 in a field that is shared with alpha Purpose Code 0 in the Defense Logistics Standard Systems (DLSS) environment. Since zero was the only available ownership code, the Components were asked to determine whether Purpose Code 0 could be restricted from use. All Components replied that Purpose Code 0 was not being used. To facilitate implementation of the SOF Ownership Code 0 while in the DLSS environment, the Components agree to restrict Purpose Code 0 from use. Bold double underscored text is used in the attachment to highlight changes from the original approved change.

Addressees are advised not to file this change in DoD 4000.25-2-M. This AMCL is being provided as a planning document to assist in systems program/design efforts which may be necessary to implement the change. 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**ATTACHMENT TO APPROVED MILSTRAP CHANGE LETTER (AMCL) 15  
NEW OWNERSHIP CODE 0 (ZERO) TO IDENTIFY  
SPECIAL OPERATIONS FORCES OWNERSHIP**

**1. Proposed Change Concept/Rationale:**

**a. Concept:** Add a new Ownership Code 0 (zero) to DoD 4000.25-2-M, MILSTRAP, appendix B4, and DLMS, to identify assets owned by DoD Special Operations Forces as staffed by the August 1, 1995 Proposed MILSTRAP Change Letter (PMCL) 12.

**b. Rationale:**

(1) Public Law 99-433 directed the establishment of a Unified Combatant Command for DoD Special Operations Forces and created Major Force Program 11 funding within DoD for programming and funding for Special Operations Forces requirements. The new ownership code will provide an automated means to identify and account for assets owned by DoD Special Operations Forces.

(2) Satisfies the MIL-STD-129-1, Marking for Shipment and Storage-Ammunition and Explosives, requirement for a Special Operations Forces ownership code for shipments to Naval activities.

(3) Satisfies the Navy request for a Special Operations Forces ownership code to: enhance accountability; reduce inaccurate data processing; and eliminate the need for manual processing of transactions for Special Operations Forces-owned assets.

**2. Interface/Impact:**

**a. Interface:**

(1) Requires interface with the functional elements and support systems of munitions, inventory management, and distribution depots.

(2) Requires Supply Process Review Committee representative coordination with their MILSTRAP focal point to ensure that all interfaces are addressed.

(3) DLMSO will coordinate the revision of an approved DoD standard data element with the DoD Logistics Functional Data Administrator under the DoD Directive 8320.1 DoD Data Administration Program.

**b. Impact:**

(1) Requires modification of Service/Agency systems and procedures to recognize the new code.

(2) Requires modification of Service/Agency publications and procedures to restrict alpha Purpose Code 0 from being assigned/used. This restriction is made to avoid confusion with numeric ownership code 0 since ownership code and purpose code share a field in the 80 -record position Defense Logistics Standard System transaction formats.

**3. Procedures:**

a. DLMS. Add the following new code to Data Element 1270 Code List Qualifier Code A1, Ownership Code (the qualifier code list is available from the DLMSO website at: <http://www.dlms0.hq.dla.mil>):
