## 4. REQUESTED CHANGE(S):

**a.** <u>Brief Overview of Change</u>: This change updates the documentation for the DLA Energy (2A series) DoDAACs.

**b.** <u>Background</u>: DLA Energy Special Program DoDAACs begin with 2A, which classifies them as a Special Program. This designation supports DoDAACs not limited to single organization type (e.g., DOD or Federal). The DLMS manual awkwardly phrased organization type restriction to imply neither DOD nor Federal. This change clarifies the DLM 4000.25 wording.

## c. <u>Requested Change in Detail</u>:

(1) <u>Revision to DLM 4000.25, Volume 6, Chapter 2</u>: Changes are identified in *red bold italics*.

C2.4.1.4. Special Program DoDAACs. Special Program DoDAACs are identified by a numeric character in the first position followed by an alpha

character in the second position. These identify entities that are **not limited to a single organizational type** neither DoD nor other Federal entities and that are associated with a special program. Among other purposes, special programs include programs authorized by Congress for state and local entities to purchase materiel from Federal sources. DoD and Federal Agency sponsors of these programs are designated as DoDAAC monitors. Contact the DoDAAD System Administrator for guidance on establishing a DoDAAC series for a special program.

**d. REASON FOR CHANGE:** This change improves readability and eliminates confusing wording currently used to identify Special Program entities.
